
Houston Pilots Forecast Package

Weather Headlines

- Not favoring any fog concerns at this time. High confidence exists that fog will not be concern at least through Thursday.
- Anticipating dry conditions this afternoon and evening, with a slight (20% chance) for drizzle after 12 AM.
 Substantial rain will enter the region tomorrow morning around 8 AM. 1 2 inches of rain will be possible Tuesday with a few locally higher amounts possible.
- Elevated winds will be in the cards over the next 72 hours in the 10 – 20 kt range. Tuesday looks to be a very gusty day ahead of a cold front, where gusts could reach as high as 40 – 45 kts in the afternoon. Please see further details on each daily slide.
 - Worth keeping eyes out on Wednesday Thursday for lower water levels over the bay from prolonged elevated NW winds.





Forecast Discussion

Precip: A few pockets of light drizzle will be possible after 12 AM across all stations. Chance of drizzle is 20%. There will be a 30% chance for showers north of Morgan's Point by 5 AM.


Wind: Sustained winds from the E this afternoon with slight veering from the ESE towards midnight. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 3 - 8 kts and S of Morgan's Point will be 10 – 15 kts. Winds at the Boarding Station will be in the same range, but slowly increasing towards 14 - 20 kts as we approach the midnight hour. Wind gusts can range from 21 - 24 kts after 9 PM mainly at the Boarding Station and 11/12.

Temps: Low temperatures Tuesday AM will be in the lower 50s F N of Morgan's Point and in the mid 50s F S of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.


HRRR | 10-meter Wind Speed [mph] & Direction

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions until about 8 AM. After 8 AM showers and potentially thunderstorms will begin to fill in the region throughout the morning hours, with the heaviest of rain occurring from 10 AM – 7 PM. Anticipating the cold front to pass through the region by 8 PM, bringing dry conditions for the late evening hours. The risk for severe weather will be present 1 – 6 PM where heavy rain, lightning, damaging winds will all be possible.


Wind: Winds will be out of the E most of the day AM. N of Morgan's Point is 13 - 18 knots with gusts 20 - 25 knots, S of Morgan's Point is 20 - 25 knots and gusts 25 - 35 knots. When the front passes winds turn more out of the S and there can be gusts of 40+ knots between 1 - 6 PM at stations S of Morgan's Point.


Temps: High temperatures Tuesday will be in the mid 60s F across all stations.

Visibility: Not anticipating a fog threat for visibility concerns, however heavy rain, especially during the 1 PM – 6 PM timeframe could reduce visibilities to less than 2 miles at times.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Anticipating dry conditions throughout the day.


Wind: Sustained winds will be from the NW for the entire day Wednesday. Winds N of Morgan's point will range from 10- 16 kts, and S of Morgan's Point will be more elevated at 14 - 19 kts. After 5 PM winds N of Morgan's Point will calm to 3 - 7 kts and winds S of Morgan's point will be at 9 - 15 kts. A few pockets of up to 17 kts will be possible at the boarding station after 5 PM. Wind gusts at the Boarding Station in the AM hours could range between 25 - 30 kts from 1 - 10 AM. After 10 AM wind gusts of up to 25 kts will be possible across all stations until 5 PM.

Temps: Much cooler behind the cold front. High temps Wednesday will be in the mid 50s F across all stations.


Visibility: Not favoring fog to be a concern at this time.


Wind Speed

Precip Forecast: 12 PM CT






High Temps Wednesday
