- Pockets of lower visibility have been noted in spots across the channel, most notably near 37/38. There is lower confidence moving forward on both coverage and timing as it is rare to have a northerly wind allowing sea fog development, and fog being as hit and miss as it is.
- The concern is that there can continue to to be these isolated instances of fog into the evening and overnight hours. As of this update we do not expect this to increase to a widespread threat, however the threat moving from now into tomorrow AM is for there to be patchy spots of fog (less than 2 miles of visibility) between 11/12 and Morgan's Point.
- There is 0 model support for this patchy fog which also leads to the lower confidence, but given the persistence of some reports of lowered visibilities + the patchy nature of things, we cannot fully take this out of the forecast through tomorrow AM.

#### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Anticipating a ~20% chance of isolated showers throughout the rest of the day. There will be continued pockets of drier time through the rest of the day.

Wind: Sustained winds will be out of the NNW throughout entire day today. Winds are generally 13-18 knots for most stations, with gusts at times 18-23 knots at the boarding station.


Temps: Lows fall back into the lower to mid 40s for most stations tonight.



#### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Anticipating on and off precip for Tuesday with a 30% chance of scattered showers from 12AM – 6 AM. After 6 AM favoring scattered showers to fill in more, bringing a 40% chance of precipitation from 6 AM – 8 PM. After 8 PM shower activity will decrease in coverage to 30% once more.

Wind: Expecting winds to stay primarily out of the N at 10 – 15 knots and gusts at 15-20 knots for the boarding station. Winds North of Morgan's Point will be 5-10 knots.


Temps: High temperatures Tuesday will be in the mid to lower 60s F across all stations.



#### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Anticipating another wet day on Wednesday. Expecting 30% isolated chance of showers to continue through the early morning until 6 AM. Coverage will then increase and become more scattered through most of the day. After around 9 PM, coverage decreases and remains through midnight.

Wind: Sustained northerly winds throughout the day Wednesday. Winds will generally stay at 17 – 12 knots for stations south of Morgan's Point and 7 – 12 knots for stations north of Morgan's Point through most of the day. Gusts of 20 kts are possible throughout the day.


Temps: Low temps Monday Morning near 60 F at the Boarding Station and in the mid to upper 50s F at all other stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating fog activity at this time, however, visibilities may be reduced due to shower activity. Lower confidence on this risk.

Wind Speed 12 PM CT
























- Anticipating the next rain chances to come Saturday and continue into the early half of next week. Temps will be slightly above normal in the 1 week timeframe.
