

Weather Headlines

- Fog is expected to slowly lift during the late AM to early PM hours today. Check the visibility slides for more details. Daily fog chances will be on the table through Thursday before a strong cold front works through and wipes fog chances out by Friday.
- Isolated shower chances on the order of <20% are expected throughout the week.</p>
- Highest risk of seeing waves at/just above 6-8+ feet comes late Thursday afternoon through daybreak Friday. This will because of strong Southerly winds.
- Thursday looks to hold particularly strong sustained winds in the 15 – 20 kt range with gusts of up to 30 kts possible. As the cold front arrives late THU PM/Early FRI AM, gusts could be as high as ~40 kts






TIMEFRAME THREAT
DISCUSSED

CURRENT - 3 PM TUE High

- Areas of dense fog will be ongoing over the next few hours, with best chances of seeing lingering dense fog <2 miles at stations south of 11/12.
- From the 8 10 AM timeframe, any isolated areas of fog that are North of Morgan's Point would be lifting and would not be much of a concern.
- Stations south of Morgan's Point and North of 11/12 would see any patchy fog lift between 11 AM 1 PM. This area is most likely to have varying visibilities given the patchy nature of things.
- South of 11/12 will continue to run the highest risks of seeing the most widespread and dense fog lingering into the early PM hours. Visibilities of less than 1 mile will be possible, with the best risk of fog lifting comes between 1-3 PM.







- ➤ Lower than average confidence on the Wednesday AM fog threat.

 This threat is lower than the ongoing fog threat.
- ➤ There are several pieces of data not hinting at fog tomorrow (with the better threat coming Wed night- Thu AM which we agree with).
- ➤ With that said, we do believe patchy fog is at least possible for stations South of Morgan's Point developing as early as midnight and lingering in an on/off nature through 10A Noon.
- ➤ Details will certainly need refined on this threat. Once again, best overall chances for dense fog sits at the boarding station.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring mostly dry conditions with a 10% chance for an isolated light shower during the late AM early PM hours.

Wind: Light winds will be from the SSW during the morning and early afternoon at 3-8 MPH. Winds will shift more from the SSE after 3-4 PM. Winds after ~4 PM will sit 8-13 knots with gusts 13-18 knots at the boarding station.


Temps: High temperatures today will be in the upper 70s F north of Morgan's Point and in the mid 60s F to near 70 F south of Morgan's Point.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions throughout the day Wednesday. An isolated 20% chance for a light isolated shower between 10 AM – 2 PM, anticipating the better rain chances to remain N. of HOU Metro.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the S - SSE all day. Winds north of Morgan's Point will be at 6 – 10 kts until 9 AM where winds increase to 10 – 15 kts and stay that way the rest of the day. Winds south of Morgan's Point will be at 10 – 15 kts throughout the day with occasional gusts 18 - 23 kts.


Temps: High temperatures Wednesday in the 70s F for stations south of Morgan's Point. Stations north of Morgan's Point in the near 80s F.


Visibility: Patchy sea fog will once again be possible (biggest threats coming in the early-mid AM hours & after sundown). Slightly elevated winds during the day likely limit the threat for the late AM – mid PM hours.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Thursday leading up until about 10 AM where light showers ahead of a cold front will allow for 20% chances. A strong cold front looks to push through the area around ~10 PM, and with it a brief period of moderate rain will be possible from 10 PM – Midnight.

Wind: Sustained winds will start from the SE during the AM hours and will then veer slowly to the S ahead of the cold front between 7 to 9 PM. Winds will then flip from the NW by Midnight. Winds will start out during the AM hours at 8-14 kts across all stations, increasing to 15-20 kts by 12 PM. From 6 PM -9 PM, winds south of 25/26 will increase even more to 22-27 kts. Wind gusts post 12 PM across all stations will range from 25-33 kts. As the cold front presses through, gusts of 35-40 kts will be possible across all stations from 9 PM - Midnight.


Temps: High temperatures Thursday will be near 80 F north of Morgan's Point and in the mid to lower 70s F south of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Reduced visibilities via sea fog will be possible during the AM and early afternoon hours, especially ahead of the cold front with plentiful low-level moisture and southerly winds. After the cold front pushes through during the late evening, this will wipe out all fog threats for Friday AM

Wind Speed 8 PM CT



























- Isolated / low end shower chances will be possible the next several days with a front stalled/hanging around the area. Best chances for precip will come Thursday PM/ Friday AM pending the timing of a cold front. Temperatures are expected to be well above average over the next seven days.
- Expecting below normal precipitation chances and above normal temperatures extending into the week
 2 timeframe.
- Anticipating equal chances for precipitation and above normal temperatures favored in the week ¾ timeframe.
