- Scattered showers/storm chances expected to continue over the next couple days. Rain showers will exit the picture Thursday evening, bringing dry conditions for Friday.
- Favoring the next three days to hold winds in the 10-20 kt range, with a few gusts of 20-25 kts possible at times at the Boarding Station.





Houston Pilots Visibility Report





	ortheasterly winds will continue for the majority of the afternoon, making
w	idespread sea fog impacts unlikely. That being said, reduced visibilities
w	ill be possible due to a low cloud deck and misty conditions.

- Favoring visibilities to at times become patchy and within the 3 6 mile range across all stations. As we head towards sundown there is the risk that this low cloud deck could lower and cause brief pockets of less than 2 mile visibility (in patchy nature) south of Morgan's Point.
- Lower confidence remains as to when misty conditions/light fog threats could lift. It is possible this threat for a low cloud deck and visibilities reduced to 3 - 6 miles lasts through the morning Thursday (greatest threat between 7 AM – 12 PM) with visibilities improving after the noon timeframe.

NE winds during the AM hours will begin to veer from the SE towards the late evening hours. Winds will be quite calm however, making sea fog transport unlikely.

Sunday 2/5/23

Light and variable winds with favorability from the SE will be possible. Again, due to the light nature of the winds, it will be hard to tap into sea fog transport with SE winds.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: 30% chance of hit and miss showers to continue into the afternoon/evening hours. A few rumbles of thunder will be possible.

Wind: Sustained northerly winds throughout the day Wednesday. Winds will generally stay at 13 - 17 kts for stations south of Morgan's Point and 7 – 12 kts for stations north of Morgan's Point through most of the day.


Temps: Lows Tuesday AM will be in the near 40s. The Boarding Station will be in the upper 40s F



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Light to moderate rain showers look to enter the picture around 4 AM and could linger on as late as 6 PM. After 6 PM favoring dry conditions. The best window to receive rain will be from 5 – 8 AM (60%) outside of this window precipitation chances will be 40%.

Wind: Sustained northerly winds in the AM hours will veer from the NNW around 2 PM and remain as such for the rest of the evening. Winds north of Morgan's Point will be 7 – 12 kts for the entire day. Winds south of Morgan's Point to 25/26 will be at 9 – 15 kts. The Boarding Station and 11/12 will be at risk for slightly higher winds at 14 – 18 kts. Wind gusts of 22 – 25 kts will be possible at 11/12 and the Boarding Station mainly between 6 and 11 PM.


Temps: High temperatures Thursday will be in the mid to upper 40s F across all stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating widespread fog threats for Thursday, however Wednesday's visibility threat could linger into Thursday morning. Check visibility slide for more details.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for Friday.


Wind: Sustained winds will be from the North and will veer from the NNE around 10 PM. Winds north of Morgan's Point will be 7 – 10 kts and south of Morgan's Point will be elevated at 12 - 17 kts. A few pockets of up to 20 kt winds will be possible at 11/12 and the Boarding Station during the morning hours. Towards 12 PM winds South of Morgan's Point will calm slightly to 9 – 14 kts. Winds North of Morgan's point will also calm to 4 – 8 kts after 5 PM. Wind gusts of 22 - 27 kts will be possible at 11/12 and the Boarding Station from 1 - 10 AM.

Temps: High temperatures on Friday will be in the mid 50s F across all stations.

Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.


ECMWF 0.1° Init 18z 31 Jan 2023 • 10m Wind Speed + Stre




Wind Speed

10 AM CT




