

- Favoring drier conditions over the rest of the weekend, with the next low-end spotty shower chances across the area during midday Monday.
- A low-end radiation fog threat will be possible starting early Sunday morning, lasting into mid-morning Sunday.
- Winds will stay rather light over the next three days with ranges staying within 5 – 15 kts.

Southeasterly winds will still be prominent for Thursday, allowing for the continuation of sea fog threats. A cold front does look to push through the area Friday (3/10 PM)



## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions throughout the rest of the day today.

**Wind:** Sustained winds will be out of the E-ESE for the remainder of the day. Winds N of Morgan's point will be at 3 – 5 kts throughout the entirety of the day, with winds of 6 - 11 kts for locations S of Morgan's point through the Boarding Station.



**Temps:** Low temperatures Sunday morning will be in the low-mid 60s F for stations S of Morgan's Point. Low temperatures will be in the mid-upper 50s F for stations N of Morgan's Point.

**Visibility:** A low risk for radiation fog will be possible Sunday morning N of Morgan's Point. (View Visibility Slide)

# Houston Pilots: Sun. 3/5/2023

## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions throughout the day Sunday.

**Wind:** Sustained winds will start out of the E early Sunday and gradually shift to out of the SSE by 11 AM CT. Winds will be at 3 – 10 kts throughout the early morning hours for all stations Sunday. After 10 AM, winds pick up to 7 – 14 kts across all stations through 8 PM. After 8 PM, winds N of Morgan's Point will decrease to 3-5 kts for the rest of the day.



**Temps:** High temperatures Sunday be in the mid to lower 70s F at all stations.

**Visibility:** Not anticipating any fog concerns at this time.

# Houston Pilots: Mon. 3/6/2023

## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** From 6 AM– 4 PM, a 30% chance for scattered showers will be possible. After this, anticipating dry conditions for the rest of the day Monday.

**Wind:** SSE winds during the AM hours will become more southerly approaching the 10 AM hour and remain as such for the afternoon. Winds will primarily stay within 3 – 8 kts across all stations, with south of Morgan's Point increasing to 6- 11 kts after 10 AM.



**Temps:** Much above average temperatures will be in the low to mid 80s F north of Morgan's Point and in the mid to upper 70s south of Morgan's Point. The boarding station will be in the lower 70s F.

**Visibility:** Sea fog threats will be valid for Monday as SSE winds and spotty showers about the area will provide low level moisture.

# Houston Pilots: 3/4/23



- Low end rain chances will be possible mid to late next week, with better chances for precipitation just to the north of the bay. Temperatures are expected to be above normal over the next seven days.
- Expecting near normal precipitation chances and below normal temperatures extending into the week 2 timeframe.
- Anticipating below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation favored in the week 3/4 timeframe.
