

### **Weather Headlines**

- Favoring dry conditions this evening when low end spotty showers possible getting into tomorrow late AM into the early PM.
- Reduced visibilities continue to be reported at the Boarding Station this afternoon. Would anticipate fog to work back into the Bay later this evening. View visibility report for more details.
- Winds will stay rather light over the next two days with ranges staying within 5 – 15 kts, with increased winds starting Saturday.









TIMEFRAME DISCUSSED	THREAT
CURRENT – 9 AM FRI	Medium

- ➤ Clear conditions for the majority of stations at this time with periods of visibility reduced to less than 2 miles being reported at the Boarding Station and Station 11/12.
- Anticipating patchy fog to gradually begin to work back into the Bay after 7 PM this evening, moving in from the South to the North, impacting mostly stations South of Morgan's Point.
- Visibilities for all stations will likely be reduced to 2 4 miles for extended periods of time. Anticipating fog to be the most widespread and dense between 9 PM tonight and 3 AM tomorrow where visibilities of less than 2 miles will be possible for all stations. Stagnant winds will encourage this fog to develop over stations N of Morgan's Point.
- Would anticipating fog to begin to gradually recede back into the Gulf beginning after 3 AM, clearing up conditions for most stations by 6 AM. Patchy fog may linger at the Boarding Station until 9 AM.

#### **Sunday 3/12/23**

SW/SSW winds throughout Sunday AM before shifting NW Sunday PM. Low level saturation is expected to continue to struggle to occur at this time.

#### Monday 3/13/23

Dry low levels make sea fog development unlikely.



#### Tuesday 3/14/23

Winds out of the north make sea fog unlikely in the AM, but winds shifting back to the SE make it possible in the PM hours.



#### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions throughout the rest of the day.

Wind: Winds will generally be out of the SE - SSE. Winds will primarily stay within 4 – 10 kts until 12 PM and 8 -13 kts until 8 PM. After 8 PM, winds will calm down to 5-9 kts. There will be a brief window of 20 kts gusts for stations north of Morgan's Point from 12 - 4 PM.


Temps: Low temperatures Friday morning in the mid to upper 60s F for all stations.


Visibility: Sea fog threat returns this evening and is expected to continue through tomorrow morning. View visibility report for more details.

#### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: A weak front brings very low end shower chances (20%) north of Morgan's Point from 8 AM - 2 PM. Expect a mainly dry day Friday.

Wind: Winds will be from the S/SW at 6 – 12 kts until the weak front boundary moves in by 3 AM. Winds will then shift out of the NW briefly until 2 PM where winds will become more variable in nature at 2 -7 kts. After 6 PM, winds will gradually shift back out of the S/SSE and remain that way through the rest of the evening, with winds south of Morgan's Point increasing back to 6 – 12 kts.


Temps: High temperatures Friday will be in the low 80s F north of Morgan's Point and in the mid to lower 70s F south of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Sea fog threat remains possible throughout the morning.

#### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions throughout the day on Saturday.

Wind: Winds out of the SSE at 5 – 11 kts will shift to coming from the SW by 9 AM Saturday and remain there the rest of the day. After 9 AM, winds will increase to 11-16 kts for the rest of the day. After 9 PM, winds near the boarding station will increase to 14 – 19 kts.


Temps: High temperatures on Saturday will be in the mid 80s north of Morgan's Point and mid to low 70's south of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Not anticipating visibility issues on Saturday at this time.

Wind Speed 2 PM CT








- Anticipating near to above normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation favored in the week 3/4 timeframe.
