

Weather Headlines

- Quieter weather is expected over the next several days aside from elevated winds. Watching a cold front Friday that'll bring the next best chance for rain. A few pockets of light showers will be possible on Thursday. Friday's storms look to hold a severe weather risk with gusty winds and an isolated tornado.
- Not anticipating any fog risks over the next several days.
- Elevated winds will continue to be possible the next few days, especially south of Morgan's Point (more details on slides below.)
- Elevated winds from the S Thursday Night into Friday AM may lead to wave heights over 6ft.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions with a slight <10% chance for a sprinkle towards midnight

Wind: Sustained winds will be from the ENE for the afternoon and late evening hours, with winds weakening north of Morgan's Pont starting at 8-12 kts then 4 – 8 kts by 9 PM. Winds south of Morgan's Point will start at 11-18 kts then slightly calm to 9 – 16 kts by 8 PM. A few wind gusts at the Boarding Station can occasionally reach up to 22 kts.




Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns for the evening.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions throughout the day Wednesday.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the E and gradually shifts out of the SE by noon and stays that way the rest of the day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be at 5 – 9 kts and winds S of Morgan's Point will be at 10 – 14 kts early Wednesday AM before gradually increasing towards the noon timeframe at 11 – 16 kts for all stations. After 9 PM, winds S of 51/52 will increase to 15 – 20 kts into the overnight/midnight hour.


Temps: High temperatures Wednesday will be in the mid to lower 70s F across all stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for the AM hours with showers and thunderstorms possible starting around ~4 PM and continuing through the PM. Chance of rain 70%

Wind: Sustained winds will be from the SSE for Thursday with more of a southerly direction towards 8 PM. Winds north of Morgan's Point will start out at 8 - 12 kts and south of Morgan's Point will be at 12 - 19 kts. Winds north of Morgan's point will be increasing during the morning hours, and all stations will be at 17 - 24 kts by 12 PM and remain elevated for the afternoon hours. The Boarding station can expect wind ranges of 20 - 25 kts post 5 PM. Wind gusts will range from 25 - 35 kts throughout the day, with the best chance to see the upper end range coming from 12 - 7 PM.


Temps: High temperatures Thursday will be in the upper 70s to near 80 F north of Morgan's Point and in the mid to lower 70s F south of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Not anticipating visibility concerns at present time from fog, but heavy rain could reduce visibility.

Wind Speed 2 PM CT



























- Anticipating the next substantial shot for rain to move in Friday with a cold front, but generally drier weather is expected outside of Friday. Temperatures are expected to be below normal over the next seven days.
- Expecting above normal precipitation chances and slightly below normal temperatures extending into the week 2 timeframe.
- Anticipating above normal temperatures and equal chances for precipitation favored in the week 3/4 timeframe.
