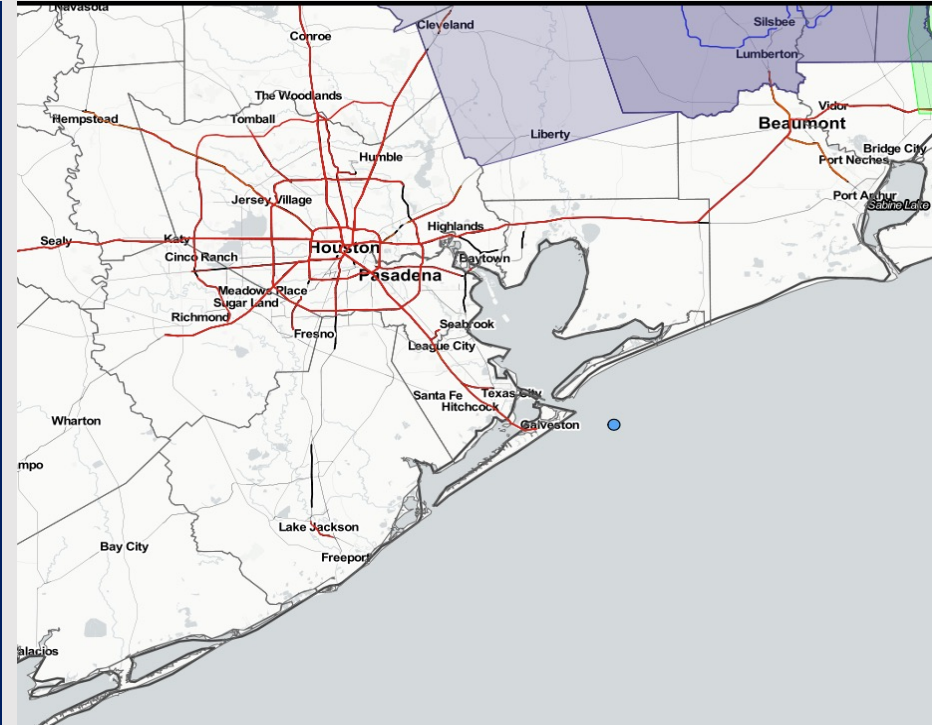

Southerly winds continue into Thursday, however, still not anticipating fog development at this time.

Southerly winds continue through the AM, shifting out of the N/NW in the PM as front passes. Not anticipating fog.



## Saturday 3/25/23

Winds out of the N/NW after front passing making fog unlikely.

## Forecast Discussion

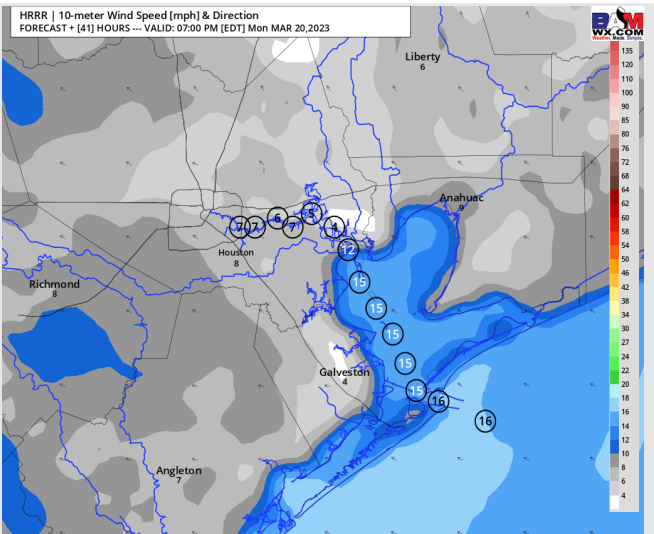
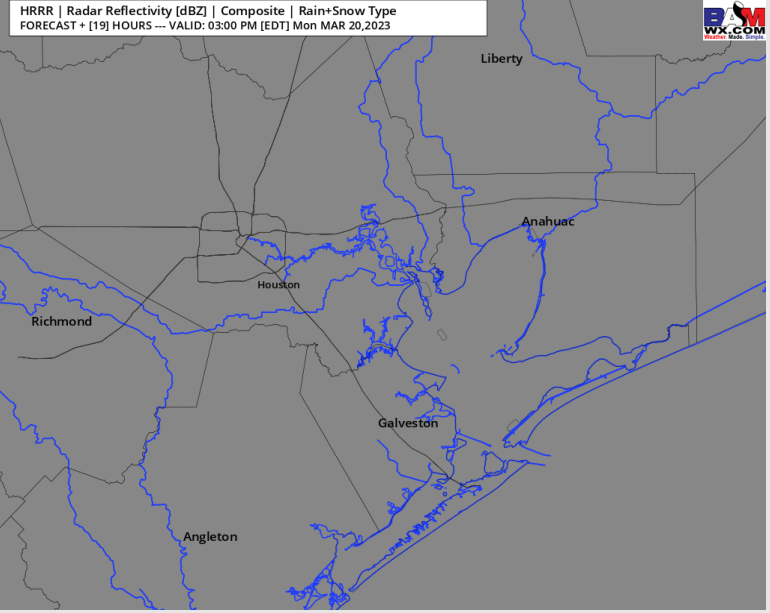
**Precip:** Favoring mostly dry conditions today outside of a 10% chance for an isolated shower this evening.

**Wind:** Sustained winds out of the east this morning where they will gradually shift out of the SE through the afternoon. Winds N of Morgan's Point at 3 – 8 kts through the AM while winds S of Morgan's Point at 10 - 15 kts. After the Noon timeframe, all winds pick up to 13 – 18 kts for all stations with a few gusts of 20 kts possible at the boarding station .

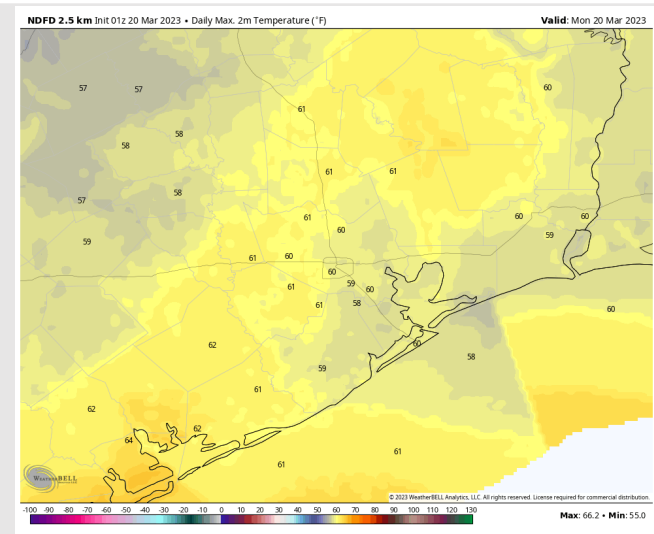
**Temps:** High temperatures at / near 60 F for all stations today.

**Visibility:** Not anticipating any visibility concerns.

## Forecast Discussion

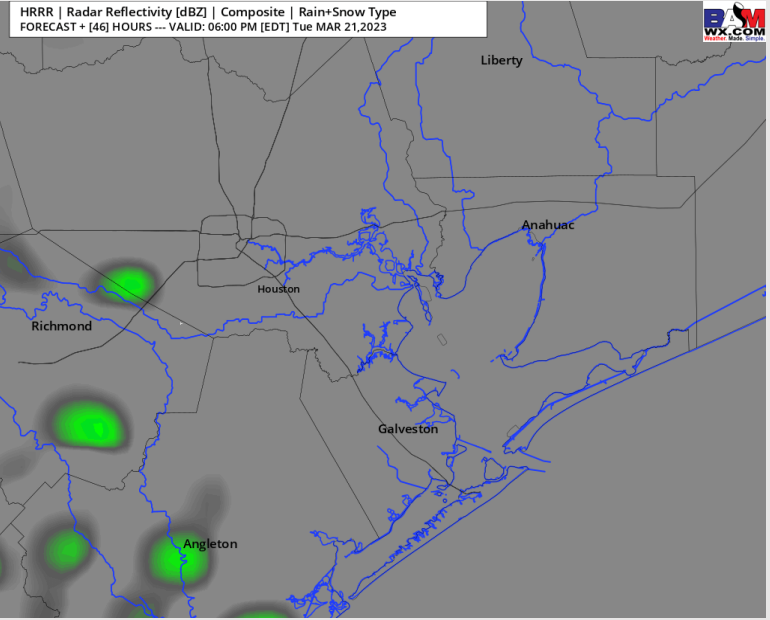
**Precip:** Anticipating a 10-20% chance for a few spotty showers in the evening (after ~4 PM) Tuesday.

**Wind:** Sustained winds will be out of the SE all day Tuesday. Winds at all stations will be 13-18 kts through 10 AM. Winds then increase slightly to 15-20 kts until 7 PM where they decrease back to 9 - 16 kts through the rest of the evening. **Gusts south of Morgan's Point at 20-25 knots will be possible most of the day.**

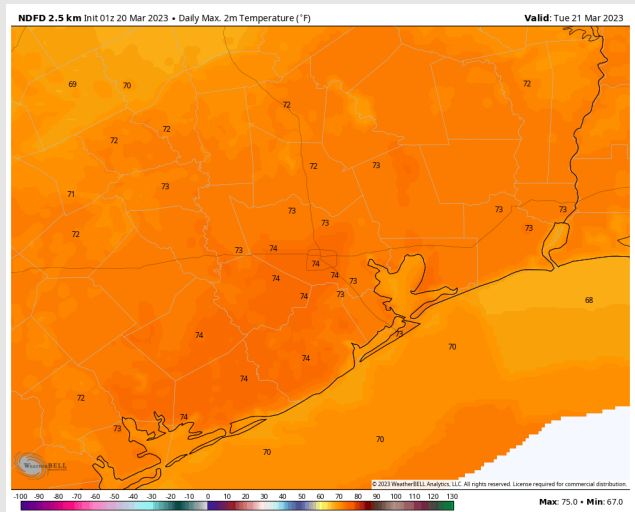
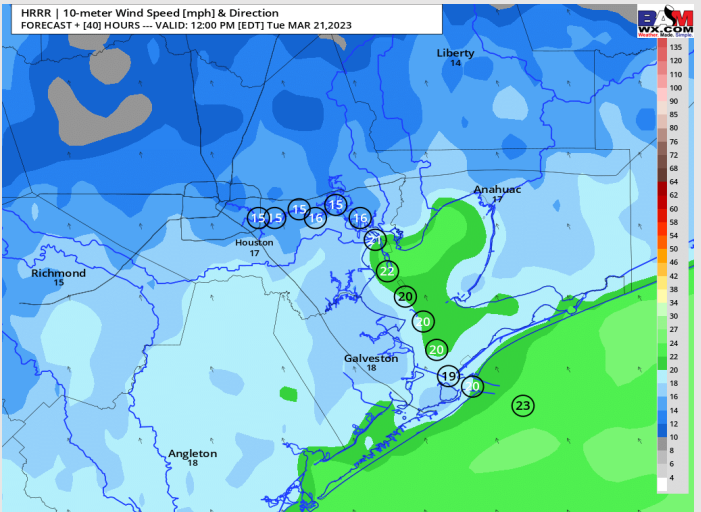
**Temps:** High temperatures on Tuesday will be in the high 60s/ low 70s F at all stations.

**Visibility:** Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

## Forecast Discussion

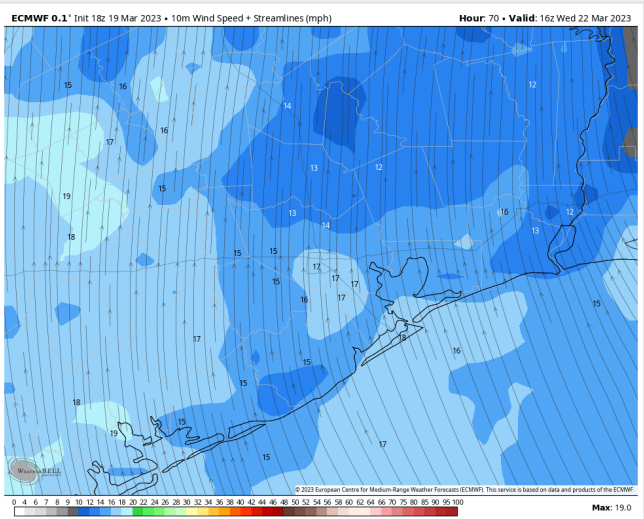
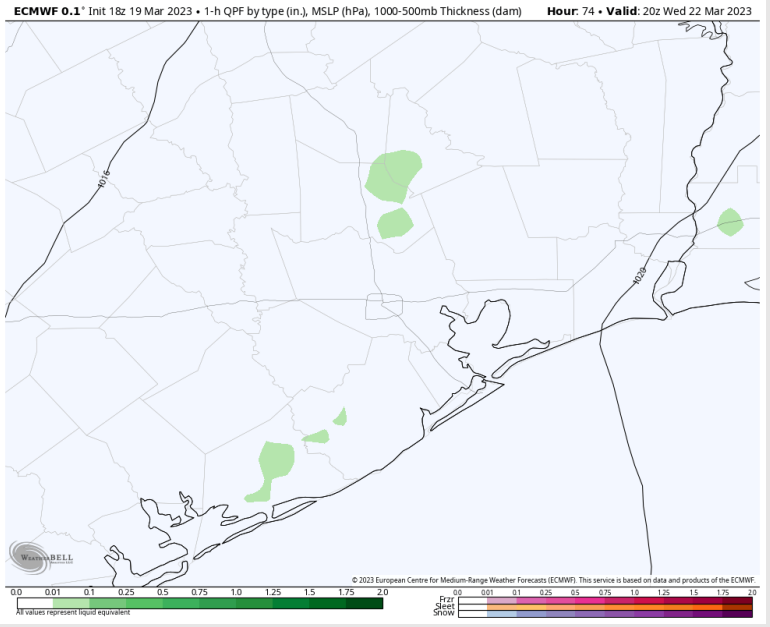
**Precip:** A few isolated showers will be possible Wednesday (10-20%), but overall favoring more dry time than not.

**Wind:** Sustained winds out of the SE throughout the day Wednesday. Winds N of Morgan's Point at 8 – 13 kts through the AM, while winds S of Morgan's Point range from 13 - 18 kts. Into the late AM and into the rest of the day, all winds will pick up to 13 – 18 kts with gusts up to 30 kts possible

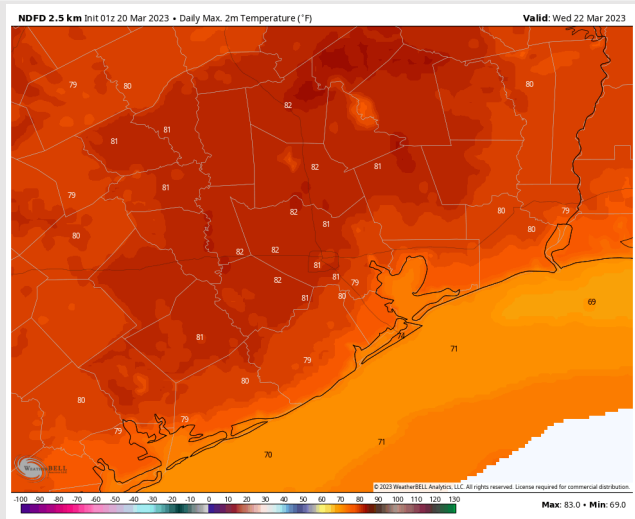
**Temps:** High temperatures Wednesday in the low 70s F at the Boarding Station and in the low 80s F for all other stations.

**Visibility:** Not anticipating visibility concerns at this time.

# Houston Pilots: 3/20/23



- Rain chances look rather minor over the next few days with a better shot of moisture moving in this weekend. Temperatures are expected to be well below normal over the next seven days.
- Expecting near normal precipitation chances and near normal temperatures extending into the week 2 timeframe.
- Anticipating above normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation favored in the week 3/4 timeframe.
