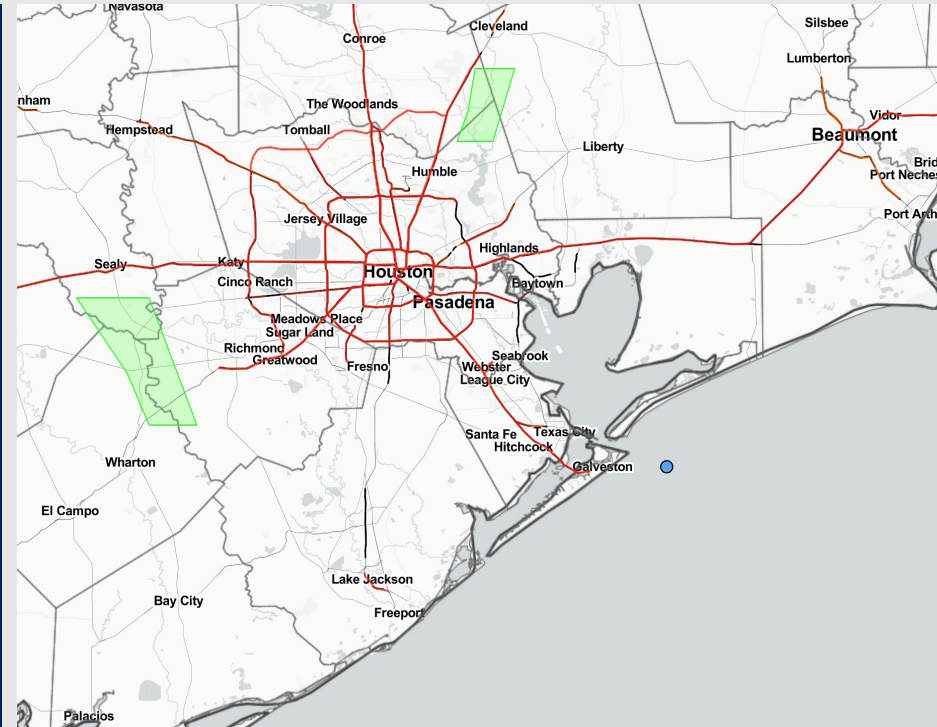

- Winds favored to remain from the N/NE over the next 72 hours generally in the 5 – 15 kt range, with a bit higher winds this evening south of Morgan's Point.
- Low end shower chances will be possible this evening and tomorrow. Rain chances increase Tuesday and will continue through the week.
- Fog threats look rather limited moving forward over the next several days.

## Forecast Discussion

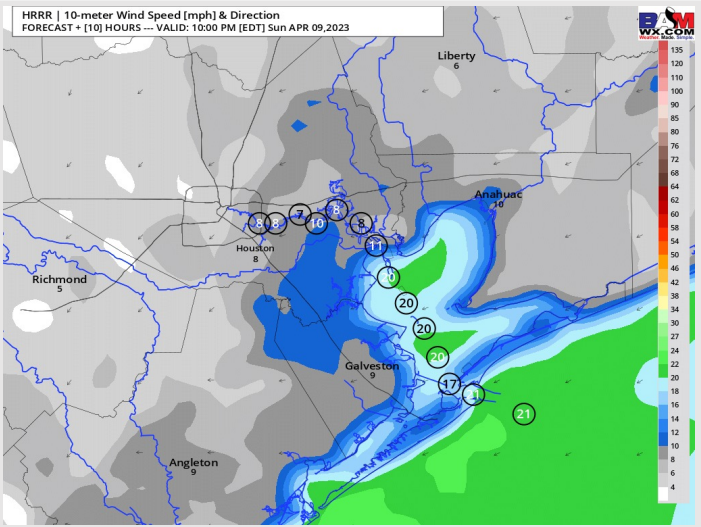
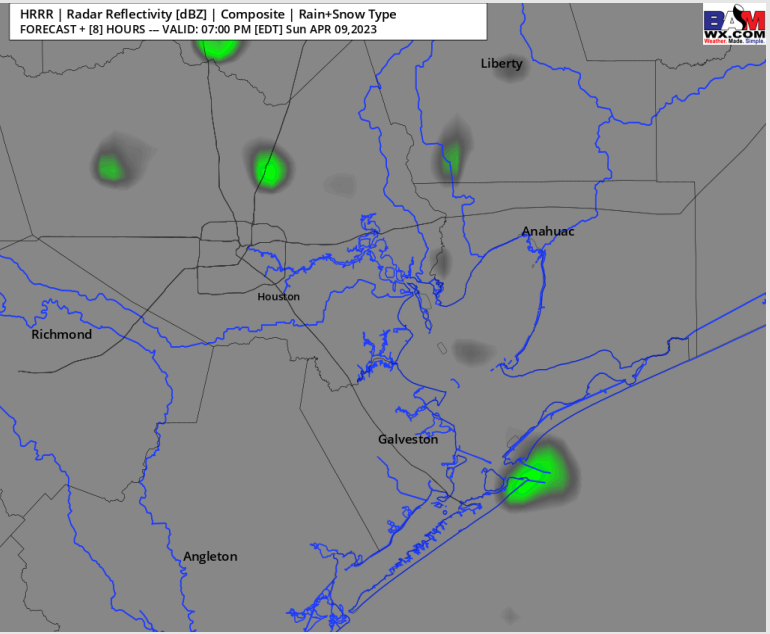
**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions throughout the afternoon, with a 10% chance for a scattered light shower or two being possible this evening after 6 PM.

**Wind:** Sustained winds will be out of the NE. Favoring winds of 4 – 8 kts for stations N of Morgan’s Point, favoring winds of 9 – 14 kts for stations S of Morgan’s Point. Towards 7 PM winds will increase slightly south of Morgan’s Point to 15 – 20 kts.

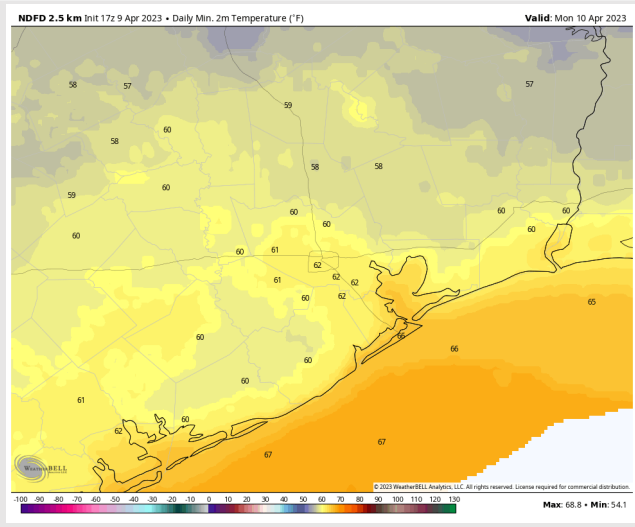
**Temps:** Low temperatures Monday Morning in the mid 60s F at the Boarding Station and in the low 60s F at all other stations.

**Visibility:** Not anticipating any fog concerns at this time.

## Forecast Discussion

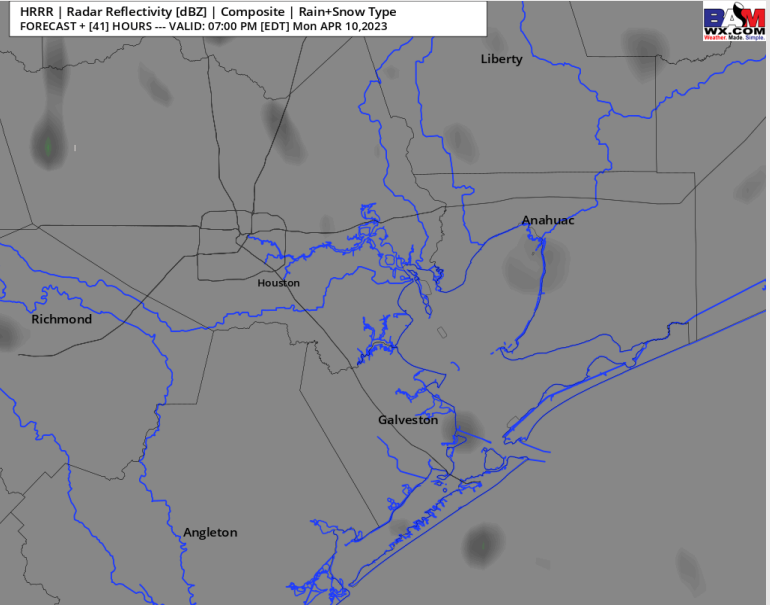
**Precip:** Isolated shower chances (10%) between 10 AM – 8 PM.

**Wind:** Sustained winds from the E/NE throughout the entire day on Monday. Winds north of Morgan’s Point will range at 4 – 9 kts and south of Morgan’s Point at 10 – 15 kts.

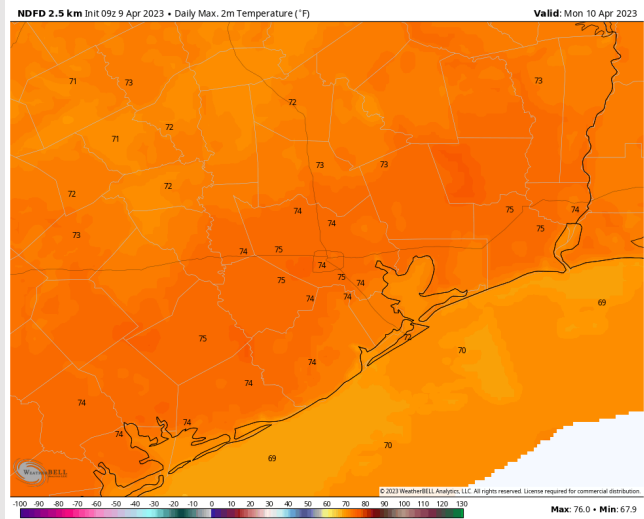
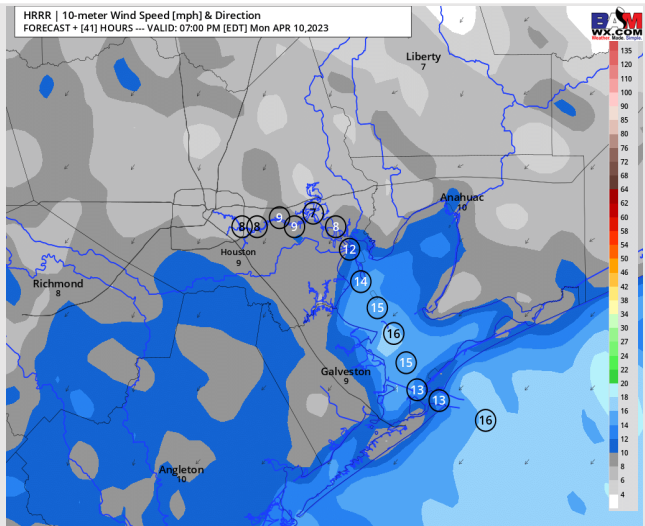
**Temps:** High temperatures on Monday in the low/mid 70s F at all stations.

# Houston Pilots: Tue. 4/11/2023

## Forecast Discussion

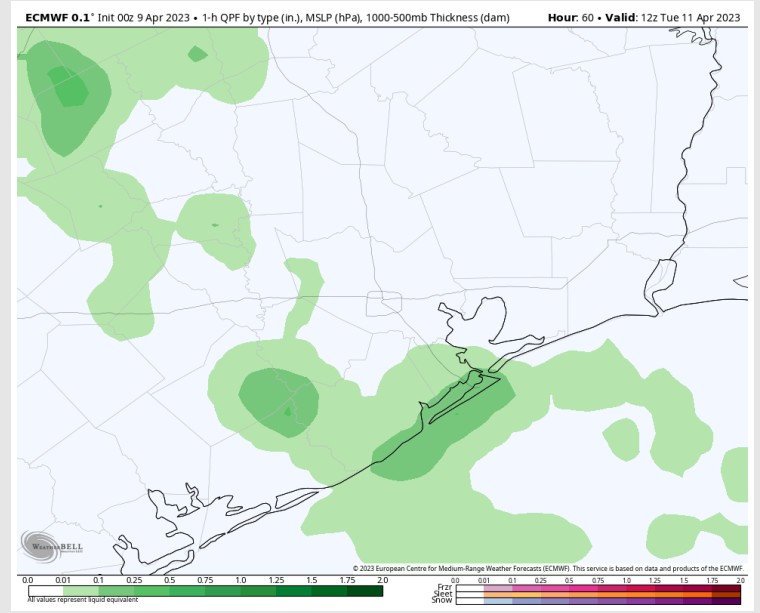
**Precip:** Scattered showers with a few rumbles of thunder will be possible, mainly south of Morgan's Point from 1 AM – 12 PM. Chance of rain 60%. After 12 PM favoring dry conditions before another wave of light rain showers tries to work in towards midnight.

**Wind:** Sustained northeasterly winds will continue for Tuesday. Winds north of Morgan's Point will start at 3 – 7 kts until 1 PM, where they will increase to 6 – 11 kts. Winds South of Morgan's Point will range will slowly increase to 8 – 14 kts by 10 AM as well. Winds at the Boarding station will also range from 8 – 14 kts, with a few sustained winds of up to 16 kts possible during the late evening hours (~10 PM).

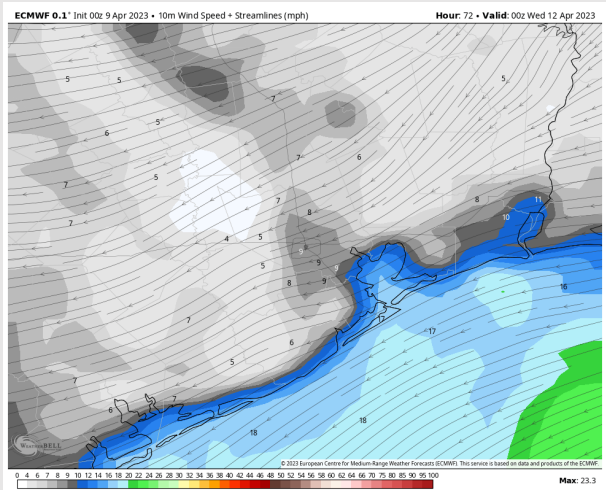
**Temps:** High temperatures Tuesday will be in the mid to lower 70s F across all stations.

**Visibility:** Visibility concerns via fog are not likely at this time.

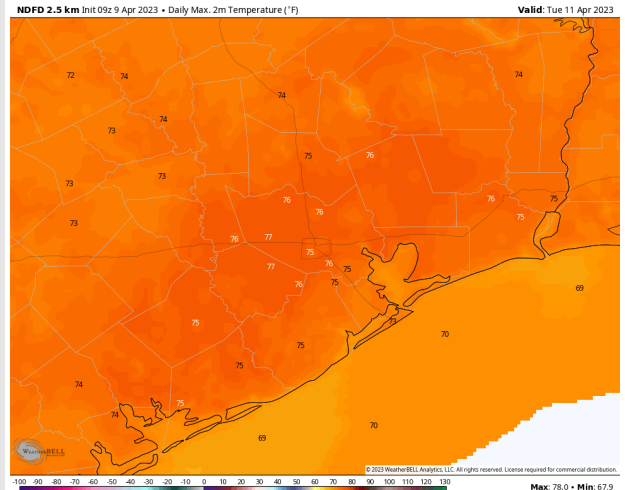

- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation favored in the week 3/4 timeframe.
