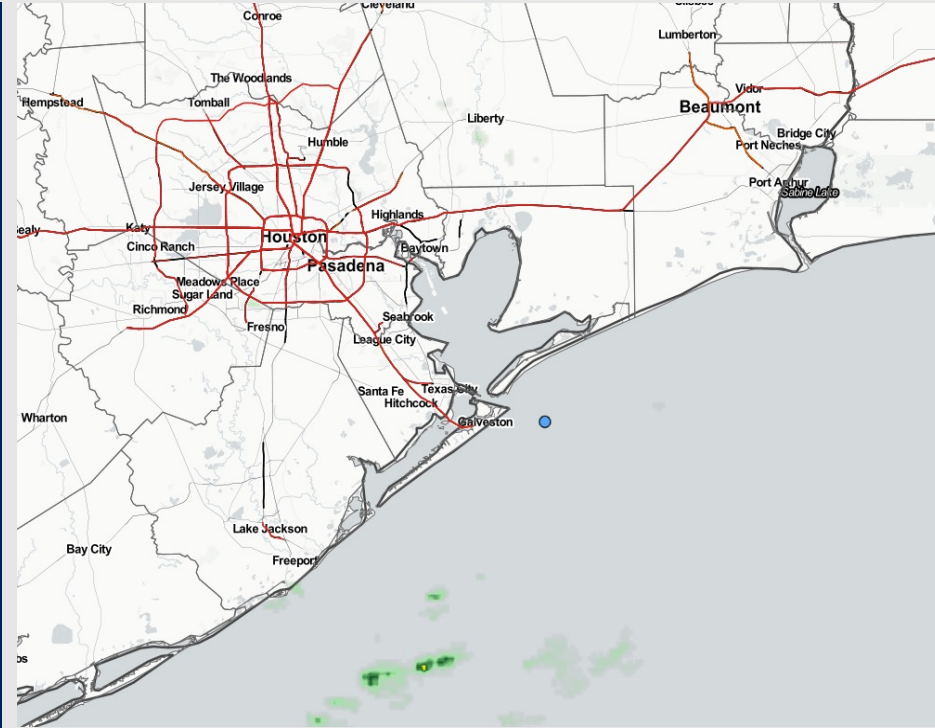

## Weather Headlines

- Winds will be slightly elevated at the boarding station the next few days, generally sustained in the 10-15 knot range (check daily slides for more specifics).
- Highest chance of rain will come Saturday PM into Sunday AM.
- Low end shower chances will continue for this afternoon/evening. Scattered rain chances increase Tuesday and Wednesday.
- Fog threats look rather limited moving forward over the next several days.

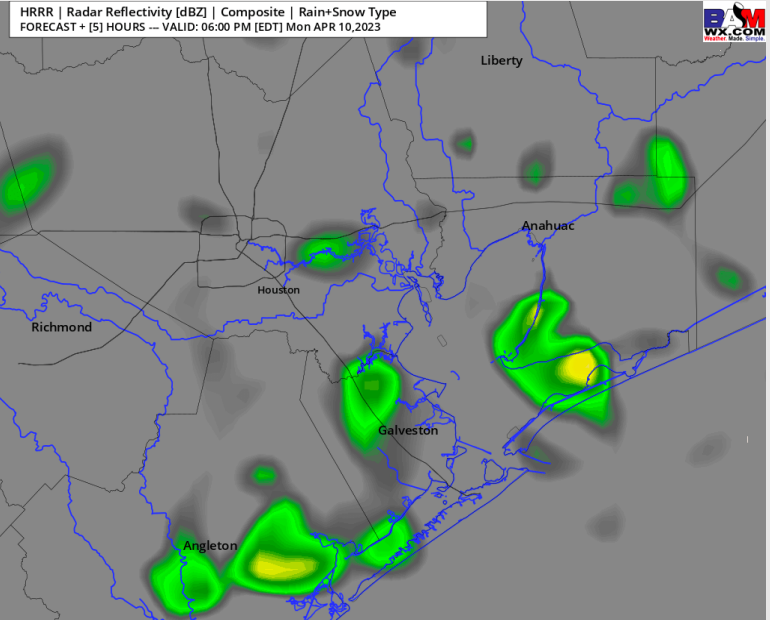

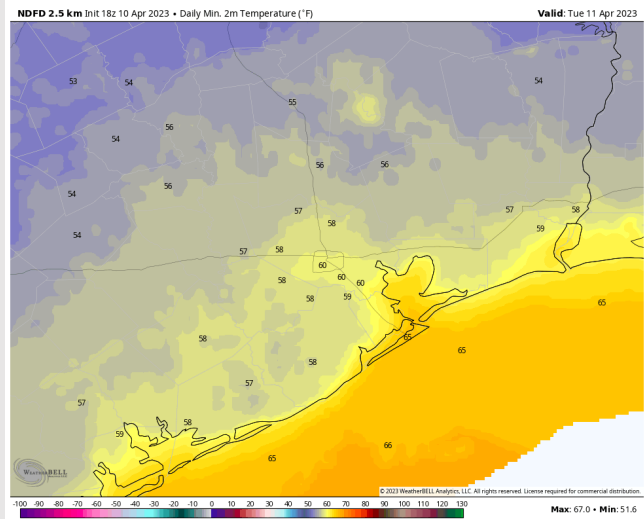
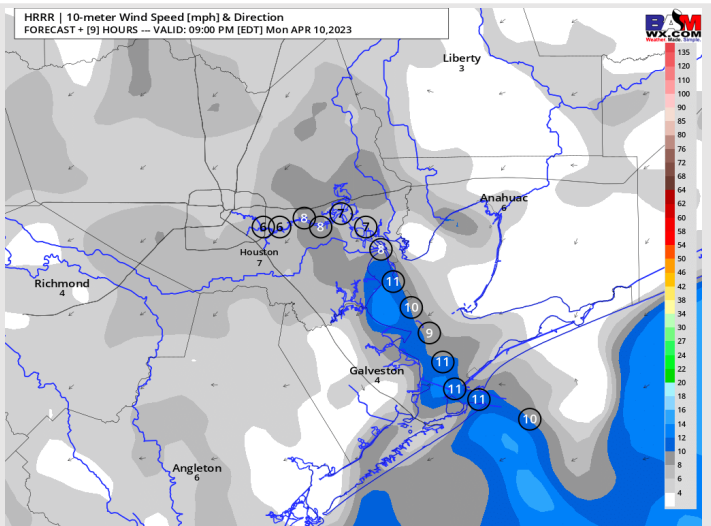
## Forecast Discussion

- Precip:** Scattered showers will continue for the afternoon and evening leading up to midnight. Chance of precipitation is 30%.
- Wind:** Sustained winds from the ENE this PM. Winds north of Morgan's Point will remain at 3 – 7 kts. South of Morgan's Point will be slightly elevated at 5 – 10 kts, and winds at the Boarding Station will be at 6 – 11 kts.
- Temps:** Low temperatures Tuesday morning will be in the mid to lower 60s F across all stations.
- Visibility:** Not anticipating visibility issues at this time.

## Forecast Discussion

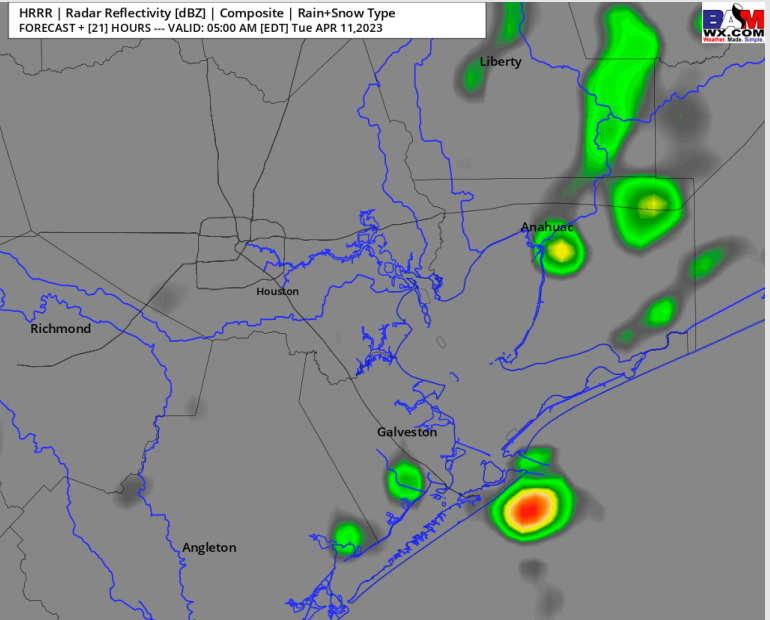
**Precip:** Scattered showers with a few rumbles of thunder will be possible, mainly south of Morgan's Point from 1 AM – 12 PM. Chance of rain 60%. After 12 PM favoring mostly dry conditions, however a few pop up showers/thunderstorms cannot be ruled out in an isolated nature for the PM hours (30%).

**Wind:** Sustained NE winds will continue for Tuesday. Winds north of Morgan's Point will start at 3 – 8 kts until 1 PM, where they will increase to 6 – 11 kts. Winds South of Morgan's Point will be 10 – 15 kts for early Tue AM with gusts 15 – 20 kts before increasing to 13 – 18 kts after 11 AM and gusts 18 – 23 kts possible.

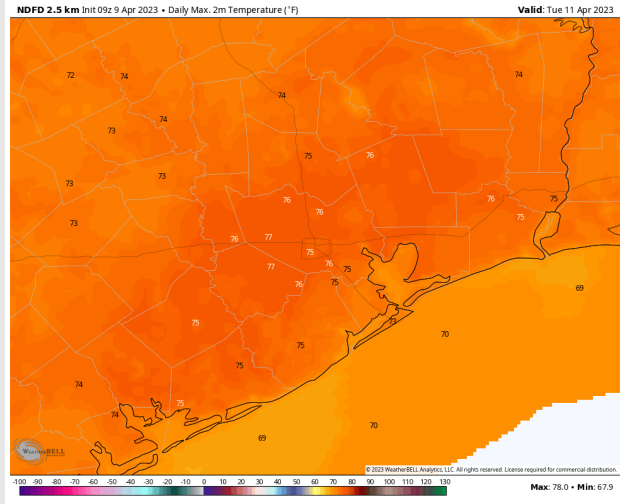
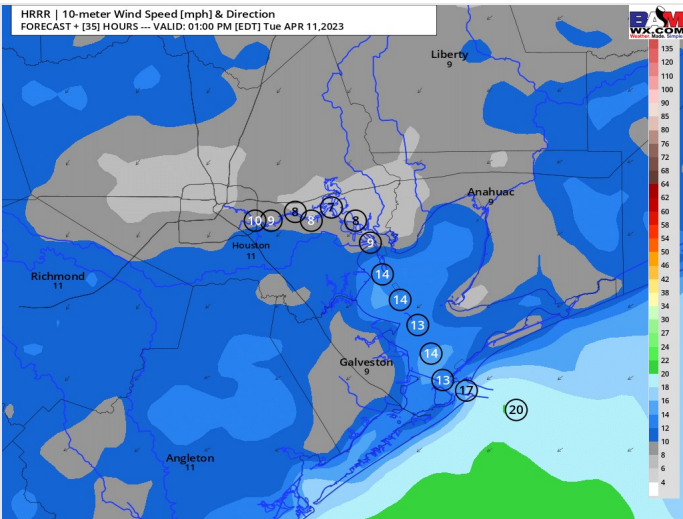
**Temps:** High temperatures Tuesday will be in the lower to mid 70s F across all stations.

**Visibility:** Visibility concerns via fog are not likely at this time.

## Forecast Discussion

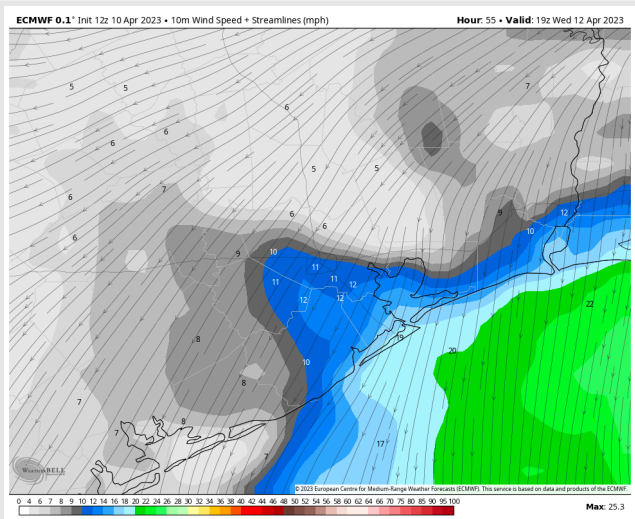
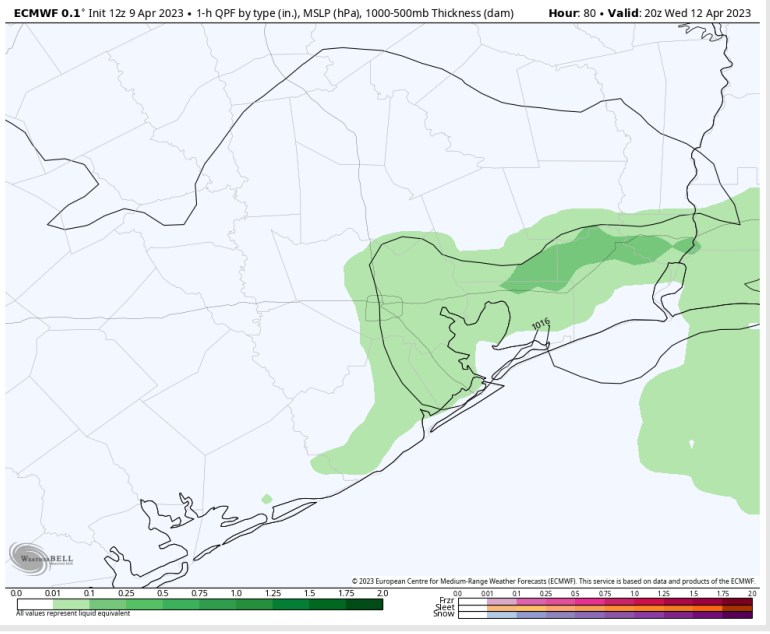
**Precip:** Isolated rain chances (20-30%) can be expected through the morning with chances increase after noon to 40% as a wave of precip moves in from the Gulf. Chances into the evening drop to 10-20%.

**Wind:** Northeasterly winds will become more northerly by the late PM hours Wednesday. Stations north of Morgan's Point will see winds of 5 - 10 kts while stations south of Morgan's Point see winds of 13 - 18 kts. Gusts of 23 kts will be possible near the Boarding Station into the PM.

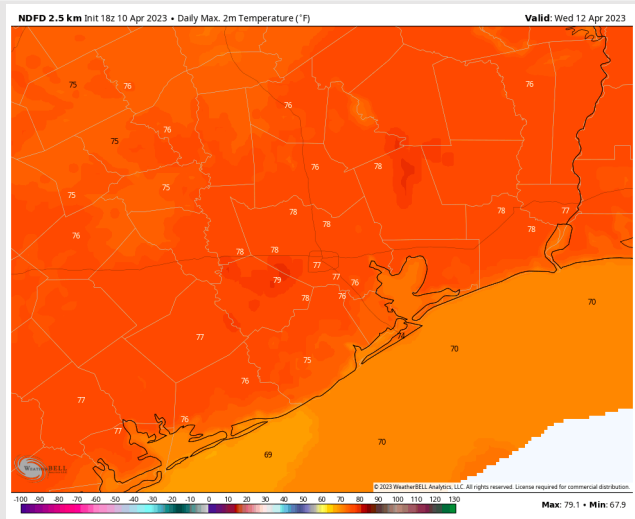
**Temps:** High temperatures Wednesday near 70 F at the Boarding Station and in the mid 70s F at all other stations.

**Visibility:** Not anticipating any fog concerns at this time.

## Precip Forecast: 3 PM CT

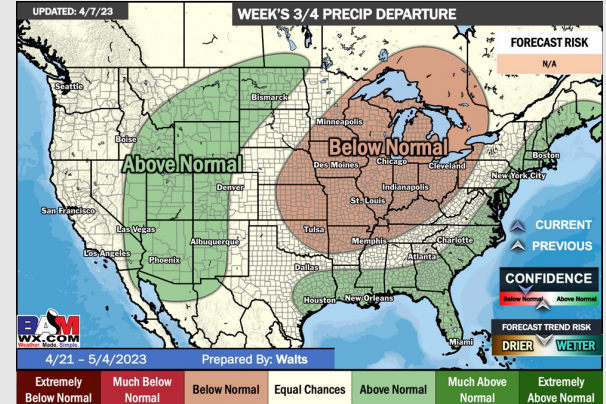
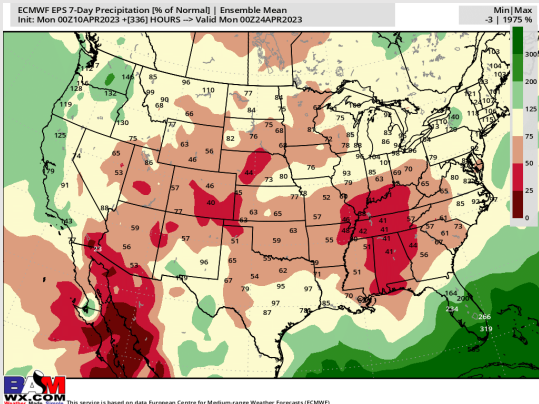
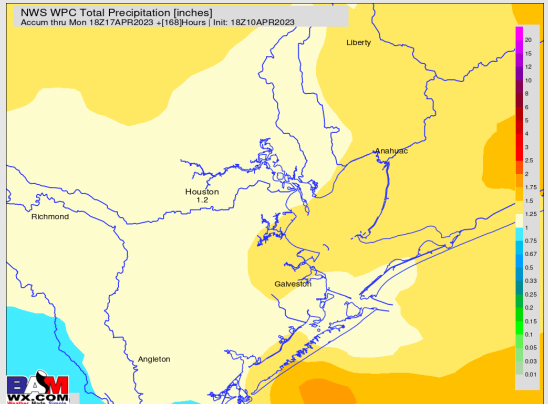
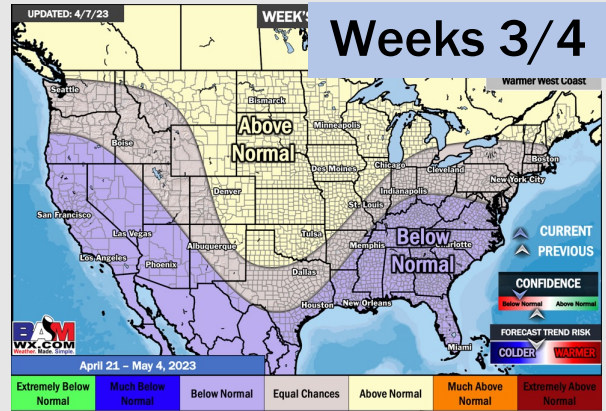
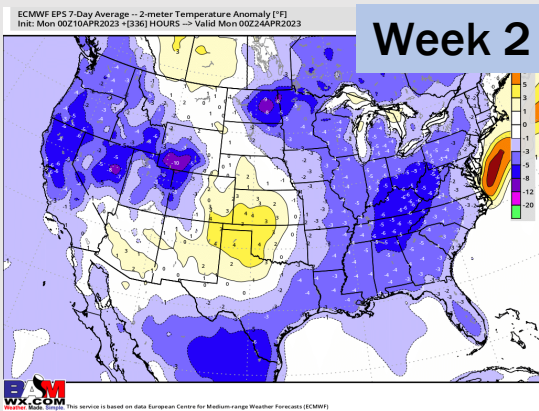
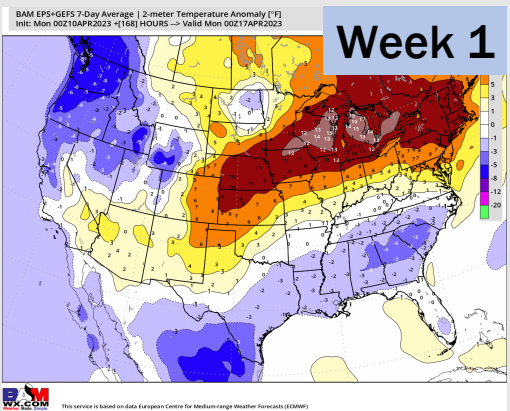

# Houston Pilots: 4/10/23



- Anticipating a few scattered rain chances at the through the first half of the week with another round likely through the weekend. Thursday looks to be the driest day with no scattered rain chances. Temps will be below average for SE TX.
- Expecting near normal precipitation chances and below normal temperatures extending into the week 2 timeframe.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation favored in the week 3/4 timeframe.
