
Houston Pilots Forecast Package

- Low end scattered rain chances will be present this morning extending through the early afternoon hours.
- Winds remain elevated at the Boarding Station the next several days (more info on daily slides).
- While timing needs ironed out, keep an eye out for this ~Saturday for a front to sweep through and sustained winds 25-30 knots possible from the N.
- Fog threats look rather limited moving forward over the next several days.
- Worth keeping eyes out towards Friday AM for severe weather potential.





Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report






Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions through 6 AM. After 6 AM, a 20-30% chance of scattered showers/ thunderstorms moves into the area, with the best window to see showers (40%) between 9 AM – 1 PM. After 1 PM favoring dry conditions.


Wind: Winds will mainly be from the S/SE all day. For Stations N of Morgan's Point winds will start at 3 - 8 kts and S of Morgan's Point will be at 10 - 15 kts. After 11 AM, winds will increase to 13 - 18 kts at all stations with the Boarding Station increasing to 16 - 21 kts sustained after 8 PM. Gusts of 20-25 kts will be possible at the Boarding Station most of the day


Temps: High temps will be in the mid to upper 70s at all stations.

Visibility: Not anticipating visibility concerns at this time.


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions Wednesday outside of a 10-20% chance for a stray shower during the late AM hours.


Wind: Winds will be out of the SE throughout the day. Winds north of Morgan's Point will start out at 6 - 11 kts and winds south of Morgan's Point will start out at 13-18 kts. Between 10 AM – 8 PM, all stations will see sustained winds of 13-18 kts with gusts at the boarding station at 18-23 kts possible.


Temps: High temperatures on Wednesday will be in the low 80s F across all stations, except the Boarding station, where it will be in the mid 70s F.

Visibility: No reduced visibility concerns expected at this time.


Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring dry conditions for the majority of the day Thursday. After 4 PM moisture from the W/NW will try to work into the area and bring precipitation chances to 20% the bulk of precipitation is favored to stay off to the northwest.

Wind: Sustained SE winds will continue Thursday. AM winds north of Morgan's point will start at 6 - 10 kts, and S of Morgan's Point at 10 - 16 kts. Around 10 AM winds Across all stations will be 11 - 16 kts and remain as such for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 22 - 25 kts will be possible across all stations after 10 AM as well.

Temps: High temperatures Thursday will be in the lower 80s F for stations north of Morgan's Point and in the upper 70s for stations south.










Low temps Tuesday AM

- Expecting a quieter stretch of weather to start the week before rain chances pick up Thursday/Friday and beyond. Temps will be near to below normal for SE TX.
- Expecting near to slightly above normal precipitation chances and below normal temperatures for the week 2 timeframe.
- Above normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation favored in the week ³/₄ timeframe.
