Weather Headlines

- Favoring dry conditions over the next 48 hours with a few windows for low end (10-20%) precip chances. Thursday looks to bring a better chance at light showers.
- Winds remain elevated at the Boarding Station over the next several days (more info on daily slides).
- While timing needs ironed out, keep an eye out for this ~Saturday for a front to sweep through and sustained winds 25-30 knots possible from the N.
- Fog threats look rather limited moving forward over the next several days.
- Worth keeping eye out towards Friday AM for severe weather potential






Forecast Discussion

Precip: A couple of exiting showers (20% chance) are expected to drift east by 3 PM, leaving dry conditions for the afternoon/evening.


Wind: Sustained SE winds will continue for the afternoon. Winds north of Morgan's Point will be 10 – 15 kts and calm to 4 – 8 kts after 8 PM. Winds south of Morgan's point will remain at 15 – 20 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts this afternoon at the Boarding Station can range from 23 – 28 kts, especially from the 3 PM – 7 PM timeframe.


Temps: Low temperatures Wednesday morning will be in the upper 60s F to lower 70s F across all stations.


Forecast Discussion

Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for Wednesday with the exception for a ~10% chance of a light shower towards the late AM.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SSE throughout the day. Winds north of Morgan's point will start at 4 - 8 kts and South of Morgan's Point at 14 - 19 kts. By 9 AM winds will be at 12 - 17 kts across all stations, with a few pockets reaching up to 19 kts towards 51/52 to 75/76. Towards 8 PM winds will begin to calm north of Morgan's point to 5 - 10 kts, but remain elevated south of Morgan's Point at 12 - 17 kts.


Temps: High temperatures on Wednesday will be in the low 80s F across all stations, except the Boarding station, where it will be in the mid 70s F.




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring dry conditions for the majority of the day Thursday. After 2 PM moisture from the W/NW will try to work into the area and bring precipitation chances to 20% the bulk of precipitation is favored to stay off to the northwest. Chances will slightly increase to 40% during the 7 PM – 10 PM timeframe.


Wind: Sustained SE winds will continue Thursday. AM winds north of Morgan's point will start at 6 - 10 kts, and S of Morgan's Point at 9 - 15 kts. Around 10 AM winds across all stations will be 10 - 16 kts and remain as such for the rest of the day, with the exception for winds calming slightly north of Morgan's Point towards 7 PM to 7 - 12 kts. Wind gusts of 22 - 25 kts will be possible across all stations after 10 AM as well.


Temps: High temperatures Thursday will be in the lower 80s F for stations north of Morgan's Point and in the upper 70s for stations south.







High Temps Thursday







Next 7 Day Total Precipitation
