

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for the majority of the day today. After 2 PM moisture from the W/NW will try to work into the area and bring precipitation chances to 20% the bulk of precipitation is favored to stay off to the northwest.

Wind: Sustained SE winds will continue today. AM winds north of Morgan's point will start at 6 – 10 kts, and S of Morgan's Point at 11 – 18 kts. Around 10 AM winds across all stations will be 11 – 18 kts and remain as such through 7 PM. After 7 PM, wind north of Morgan's point will decrease to 9-14 kts, with winds south increase to 17 – 23 kts. Wind gusts of 24 – 28 kts will be possible across all stations after 10 AM as well.


Temps: High temperatures today will be in the lower 80s F for stations north of Morgan's Point and in the upper 70s for stations south.


Visibility: No visibility issues anticipated.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Showers and thunderstorms will be present from Midnight through 9 AM on Friday then after 9 AM, favoring chances to drop to 20% for an isolated shower until around 8 PM. Then after 8 PM, favoring dry conditions for the rest of the day. A few thunderstorms do hold the potential to be severe until 9 AM. Best risk for severe weather (hall and damaging winds primarily) comes 2-7 AM FRI.

Wind: Sustained winds will start out of the SE at the beginning of the day Friday and gradually shift to out of the NW by 4 PM. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be at 9-14 kts throughout 5 AM. Then around 9-10 AM, winds N of Morgan's Point will calm down to 5-10 kts for the rest of the day. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be at 16-23 kts through 6 AM. Then, after 6 AM, winds S of Morgan's Point will die down to 5-10 kts for the rest of the day. Any severe weather Friday AM could provide some gusts 40+ knots under the heaviest of cells.


Temps: High temperatures Friday will be in the mid to upper 70s F for stations S of Morgan's Point and in the low to mid 80s for stations N of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Reduced visibility via heavy rain will be possible in the AM hours down to a few miles.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions throughout the day on Saturday.

Wind: Winds will start out of the NE throughout the AM hours on Saturday, gradually shifting out of the E by 12 PM, then the SE by 5 PM and continue the rest of the day. Winds north of Morgan's Point will be 7-13 kts and winds south of Morgan's Point being 11-16 kts through 8 PM. After 8 PM, winds both north and south of Morgan's Point will calm down to 3-8 kts and 9-14 kts respectfully.


Temps: High temperatures on Saturday will be in the lower 80s F north of Morgan's Point and upper 70s F south of Morgan's Point.







Next 7 Day Temperature Departure






8-14 Day Temperature Departure
