



- Worth keeping eyes out towards Thursday AM for some strong wind gusts associated with a frontal passage (45-55 mph possible)
- Threats for sea fog formation look very low with no strong signals over the next several days.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for this afternoon and evening, with a few spotty showers (10% chance) trying to work back into the picture towards 4-5 AM.

Wind: Sustained ESE winds expected this afternoon. Winds north of Morgan's Point will slowly subside from 5 – 9 kts to 2 – 6 kts by 9 PM. Winds South of Morgan's point will remain within 8 – 13 kts. Winds at the Boarding Station will be more elevated at 11 – 16 kts. Winds gusts at the Boarding Station will range from 18 – 20 kts, mainly until 8 PM.


Temps: Low temperatures Tuesday AM will be in the lower 60s F north of Morgan's Point and in the mid to upper 60s S of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A 20% chance for precip exists through the mid-PM hours but favoring primarily dry time across the area. Beyond 8 PM, chances rise a to 60% for an isolated shower/thunderstorm.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the SE all day Tuesday with winds north of Morgan's point will be increasing from 4 – 8 kts to 8 – 13 kts by 12 PM and winds south of Morgan's Point seeing 12 – 17 kts. Winds will increase slightly south of Morgan's point after 7 PM to 14 – 19 kts with 21 - 26 kts gusts possible, especially at near the Boarding Station.


Temps: High temperatures Tuesday in the mid 70s F at the Boarding Station and in there upper 70s F for all other stations.


Visibility: No reduced visibility concerns expected at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating scattered showers / storms Wednesday with the more widespread chances working in during the early AM. During the PM hours, activity will become much lighter and more scattered in nature. There is potential for a few stronger storms in the AM (wind gusts 30 – 38 kts) but this risk is better for stations north of Morgan's Point.

Wind: Sustained winds generally out of the ESE Wednesday. Winds N of Morgan's Point at 3-8 kts while winds south of Morgan's Point between 13-18 kts. Gusts up to 23 kts will be possible throughout the afternoon.


Temps: High temperatures in the mid 70s F at the Boarding Station with all other stations in the low 80s F.











8-14 Day Temperature Departure







- A few shots of precip coming this week, with the highest chances coming Late Tue PM/Wed AM, and then Thursday with a cold front. There is a low-end severe risk for gusty winds associated with Thursday's front. Temps will be below normal for SE TX.
- > Expecting near to just above normal precipitation chances and slightly below normal temperatures for the week 2 timeframe.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the week ¾ timeframe.
