

Weather Headlines

- Please see slide below for low end reduced visibility risks this AM. Warming waters & air temps very close to those water temps will allow for fog to continue to develop.
- Calmer winds anticipated over the weekend, with the next chance for elevated winds in the forecast being Monday PM.
- Overall, several minor chances for precipitation over the next few days with rainfall amounts generally light. Favoring periods of dryness to outweigh periods of sprinkles/showers






TIMEFRAME

Risk for a low cloud deck reducing visibility to 2 - 4 miles will continue through the rest of the morning and into the early afternoon. Warmer water temperatures next to warmer air temps will make it difficult for dense fog to form.

- A low end risk for patchy fog / a low cloud deck within the Gulf will continue, posing a risk for slightly reduced visibility down to 1 - 2 miles at the Boarding Station. This risk will also allow for patchy areas of reduced visibility of less than 1 mile throughout the area during this timeframe.
- A weak boundary is stalled out in the Gulf, keeping this 3 mile or less fog risk at the Boarding Station present into the afternoon. Greatest risk will be from 6 AM - 12 PM.

Tuesday 4/4/23

Similar to Monday, a pretty low end threat of patchy fog is possible Tuesday AM. Data has been trending weaker with this signal.

Wednesday 4/5/23

Winds out of the SW Wednesday morning, could lead to low end patchy fog risk. A passing front Wednesday evening will make fog diminish fog concerns Wednesday night.



Thursday 4/6/23

Not anticipating any fog concerns at this time due to winds out of the ENE and warmer temperatures as we get further into spring.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A 10-20% chance of isolated showers will be possible until 9 AM thus morning, with dry conditions anticipated after this for the rest of the day.

Wind: Winds will start out of the NNW at 3-8 kts through 2 PM. Winds will then shift out of the SE for the rest of the day on Saturday, but still stay at 3-8 kts.


Temps: High temperatures today will be in the mid 70's F near the boarding station and mid 80s F at all other stations.


Visibility: There is a low end risk for patchy fog development this morning . Rather low confidence on this risk, but we need to keep eyes on for reduced visibility potential out through 12 PM

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions early Sunday morning until around 5 AM. After 5 AM, favoring a 10-20% chance for showers until around 10 AM. After 10 AM, favoring dry conditions until around 11 AM. After 11 AM chances for showers and thunderstorms will increase to 60-70% until 7 PM. After 7 PM, favoring dry conditions for the rest of the day.

Wind: Favoring winds to start out of the E during the early AM hours and gradually shift to out of the by lunchtime Sunday. During the early morning hours, sustained winds will be at 2-4 kts across all stations before picking up to 7-13 kts across all stations by lunchtime and will remain that way for the rest of the day.


Temps: High temperatures Sunday will be in the mid-upper 70s F for stations S of Morgan's Point and in the low-mid 80s F for stations N of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: While fog risks are not anticipated at this moment, there will once again be a low end risk for fog in the AM hours.


Precip: A few scattered showers will be possible before sunrise Monday, then favoring dry conditions through the rest of the evening.

Wind: Anticipating winds out of the S throughout the day Monday. Winds favored to be 8-13 kts through the AM then will increase to 15-20 kts into the late AM / PM. Gusts up to 30 kts will be possible into the late PM for stations N of Morgan's Point


Temps: Favoring high temperatures Monday in the mid 70s F at the Boarding Station with all other stations seeing temperatures in the mid to upper 80s F.

Wind Speed 8 AM CT



























- Expecting the second half of the week into the weekend to be more active in terms of precip. Temperatures are expected to be above normal over the next seven days.
