

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

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions through the rest of the evening.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the SE this afternoon at 13-18 kts. After 5 PM, winds south of Morgan's point will increase to 20 – 25 kts still out of the SE. where they will continue the rest of the evening Winds will then increase to 18-23 kts after 9 PM. Gusts after 6 PM of 25 kts with gusts at 30+ kts possible at the boarding station.


Temps: Low temperatures Sunday AM in the mid 70s F across all stations.


Visibility: A low cloud deck / misty conditions will be possible through the evening hours reducing visibility at times to 4-6 miles. Not anticipating any widespread fog concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Starting out Sunday, favoring a 10-20% chance of showers through 10 AM. Favoring dry conditions until around 8 PM. After 8 PM, favoring a 10-20% chance for showers once again throughout the rest of the evening.

Wind: Sustained winds will be out of the SSE throughout the day Sunday. Favoring winds N of Morgan's Point to be 8-14 kts throughout the day Sunday. Favoring winds S of Morgan's Point to be 17-24 kts until around 7 AM. Then after 7 AM, favoring winds to decrease to 12-17 kts for the rest of the day.


Temps: High temperatures Sunday will be in the mid/upper 70s F S of Morgan's Point and in the high 80s F/near 90 F for stations N of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: While not favored, worth keeping eyes towards Sunday AM for areas of reduced visibility.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers and storms will be possible through the early AM Monday. Around the lunch timeframe, coverage will decrease to a few sporadic chances before increasing to become more widespread getting towards after sunset.

Wind: Winds Monday will be out of the SE throughout the day at 10 – 15 kts. After noon, winds N of Morgan's Point will decrease to 8 – 13 kts.


Temps: High temperatures Monday in the upper 70s F for stations South of Morgan's Point and in the mid to upper 80s F for stations N of Morgan's Point.

Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.























- Best precip overall looks to sit further west in Central TX, with low end chances for precip over the coming days. The second half of week 1 holds the greatest rain risk. Temperatures slightly above normal for this time of year.
- **Expecting above normal precipitation chances and near normal temperatures for the week 2** timeframe.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the week 3/4 timeframe.
