

Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report






Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring a 50-70% chance of showers and thunderstorms to continue through 6 PM local time, with better coverage N of the Boarding Station. Then after 6 PM favoring coverage to become spotty (20-30%) throughout the rest of the evening.

Wind: Sustained winds will continue to be out of the SSE throughout the rest of the day today. Favoring winds N of Morgan's Point to be 8-14 kts. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be 8-14 kts through 6 PM, then after 6 PM winds will increase to 15-21 kts throughout the rest of the evening.


Temps: Low temperatures Monday AM will be in the mid 70s F across all stations.


Precip Image: 8 PM CT



Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns today.








Low Temps MON AM

Precip Image: 3 AM CT





Precip: Scattered showers and storms will be possible through 3 AM Monday. After 3 AM, coverage will decrease to a few sporadic chances (10-20%) throughout 6 PM. Then after 6 PM favoring dry conditions for the rest of the day.


Wind: Winds Monday will be out of the SE throughout the day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will start of at 3-8 kts before increasing to 8-13 kts by 12 PM and remaining that way for the rest of the day. Winds S of Morgan's point will start of at 15-20 kts, then decrease to 12-17 kts by 8 AM and remain that way for the rest of the day.

Temps: High temperatures Monday in the upper 70s F for stations South of Morgan's Point and in the mid to upper 80s F for stations N of Morgan's Point.

Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.



Precip: Isolated showers and storms throughout most of the morning on Tuesday. Chances will become more widespread around the 8-9 AM timeframe and last through the evening on Tuesday.


Wind: Sustained winds Tuesday out of the SE at 12 – 17 kts south of Morgan's Point and 5 – 10 kts north of Morgan's Point. Winds will pick up to 15 - 20 kts in the afternoon south of Morgan's point.


Temps: High temps Tuesday in the mid 70s F at the Boarding Station and in the mid 80s F for all other stations.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns Tuesday.






High Temps Tuesday

- Best precip overall looks to sit further west in Central TX, with low end chances for precip over the coming days. The second half of week 1 holds the greatest rain risk. Temperatures slightly above normal for this time of year.
- Expecting above normal precipitation chances and near normal temperatures for the week 2 timeframe.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the week ³/₄ timeframe.
