

Weather Headlines

- Low end 10-20% isolated shower/thunderstorm chances will be possible today, with most (if not all) locations staying dry. Better chances for rain expected in the afternoon hours for Sunday and Monday.
- Calmer winds are favored to continue, with occasional periods of winds reaching up to 10 15 kts as storms pass through. Gusty winds of up to 30 kts will be possible under heavier cells today and 35+ kts tomorrow.
- Sea fog will not be a concern moving forward.
- No tropical threats to monitor.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: A 10-20% chance for isolated pop-up showers/thunderstorms through 9 PM timeframe, but overall favoring dry conditions for most (if not all) stations on Today. Wind gusts of 21-30 kts will be possible for areas caught under the strongest cells.

Wind: Favoring winds to transition from variable to out of the SW by 3 PM and continue out of the SW for the rest of the day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be blowing at 4-9 kts, while winds S of Morgan's Point will pick up to 9-15 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 25-30 kts will be possible under the strongest cells today.


Temps: Low temps will be in the mid to upper 70s for the Boarding Station and low 70s F for all other stations.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: A 10-20% chance for an isolated shower/thunderstorm will be possible Sunday morning. Scattered showers/thunderstorms will then make their way into the area around 12-1 PM local time lasting through 6 PM. After 6 PM, coverage will become more isolated (10-20%) throughout the rest of the evening. The main threats with these storms will be gusty winds mentioned below and lightning.

Wind: Winds will be WNW for all stations until 10 AM, at which point winds will become more variable with a tendency to be out of the NW throughout the rest of the day. Wind speeds for all stations will be at 3 – 8 kts through 2 PM, where winds increase to 12 – 18 kts from 2-7 Pm with the passing of the front. Beyond 7 PM, winds will once again calm down to 3–8 kts for the rest of the evening. Wind gusts of 35+ kts will be possible under heaviest cells between 2-7 PM.


Temps: High temps for Sunday will be in the low 80s F for the Boarding Station and in the upper 80s/low 90s F for all other stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns due to fog at this time, though visibility may be reduced under storms.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for all stations for most of the day Monday, with chances for showers between 11 AM – 5 PM.

Wind: Winds will be out of the WNW throughout the morning and into the early afternoon Monday, shifting out of the SSW by 3 PM. Wind speeds for all stations will be at 1 - 7 kts for most of the day Monday, with a brief pick up to 5 - 10 kts between 1 - 4 PM.


Temps: High temps Monday will be in the low 80s F for the Boarding Station and in the mid to upper 80s F for all other stations.


