



Forecast Discussion


Precip: A 10% chance for a few isolated pop-ups will be possible between 3 – 7 PM today, with dry conditions moving in after 7 PM. (Better coverage will remain west of the stations)

Wind: Sustained winds will begin to shift from the WNW to out of the S by 4 PM this afternoon, where they will remain the rest of the day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 2-8 kts throughout the day. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be 4 - 9 kts through 5 PM, then favoring winds S of Morgan's Point to pick up to 10 - 15kts for the rest of the day.


Temps: Low temperatures on Saturday will be in the upper 70s / low 80s F S of Morgan's Point and mid 70s F for stations N of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for majority of the day on Saturday. Rain chances will increase to 30-40% as a line of showers/storms works through the area after 9 PM and last through the early morning hours on Sunday.

Wind: Favoring winds to be out of the S/SW throughout the day Saturday. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 2-7 kts during the morning hours before picking up to 6-11 kts after 12 PM. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be 6-11 kts during the morning before picking up to 10-15 kts after 12 PM. Around 9-10 PM for all stations winds will pick up associated with the possible thunderstorms to 15 – 20kts from the N. Wind gusts of 25 – 30 kts is possible if caught under the strongest cells.


Temps: High temperatures Saturday will be in the mid 80s F near the Boarding Station, in the upper 80s F for all other stations S of Morgan's Point, and in the mid 90s F for stations N of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Scattered showers/storms will continue through the early morning hours on Sunday. A bit of uncertainty on exact exit time but anticipating chances to move out of the area by 7 AM at the latest. Dry conditions beyond 7 AM on Sunday.


Wind: Winds will start out of the N through 4 AM on Sunday, then be out of the SW throughout the rest of the day. Wind speeds N of Morgan's Point will be 10 – 15 kts through the early morning, then around 6 - 7 AM winds will decrease to 7 – 12 kts through the rest of the day. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be at 12 - 17 kts throughout the day. Wind gusts of 25 – 30 kts possible under the heaviest cells through 7 AM.

Temps: High temperatures on Sunday will be in the mid 80s F for the Boarding Station, the upper 80s F for Stations S of Morgan's Point and in the mid – upper 90s N of Morgan's Point.

Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.






