

Weather Headlines

- Please check out details on the next 2 days as there are a few shots at strong to severe storms. Confidence remains lower than average as the evolution of storms will be highly dependent on how the pattern plays out in N/ NE TX.
- Excessive heat concerns (90+ F) to continue throughout this week.
- No active tropical threats to SE TX at this time.
- No signals for fog impacting stations moving forward.
- Precip pattern looks to turn slightly less active heading into next week.



It is worth keeping tabs on Bret given how far South in the Atlantic it formed. Continuing to favor a southerly track heading into Central America in 5-7 days.

For now this is not a concern for SE TX, but certainly watching trends over the next few days for any potential concerns for early July.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Very low-end chance of an isolated shower/ t-storm through mid afternoon (10%). Beyond 3-4 PM is when chances will increase closer to 30% for a few scattered showers and thunderstorms to develop, some of which could be stronger with risks for hail. This threat will continue through around 9 PM. Coverage is expected to be hit and miss.

Wind: Winds out of the S will be 5-10 kts N of Morgan's Point throughout the rest of the day, while S of Morgan's Point they will be at 11-16 kts (gusts 15-20 knots). Wind gusts of 30-35+ kts will be possible under the strongest cells associated with thunderstorm activity after 3-4 PM. Gusts will not be this high outside of precip.


Temps: Low temperatures tonight will be in the low 80s F S of Morgan's Point and in the upper 70s F N of Morgan's Point



Forecast Discussion

Precip: Exact details will once again need ironed out as we get a bit closer, but the potential for another round of strong to severe storms working into the area will be possible in the evening hours Friday. Model data has backed off on estimated timing, so current favored guidance would suggest this threat now comes between 3 - 6 PM. However, there is lower confidence due to continued variances in speed, exact path, and timing, so chances for precip (60%) could arrive even earlier or later than current models suggest. Main risk would be strong to severe winds.


Wind: Wind speed and direction in the PM will be very dependent on the potential storm cluster, but wind gusts 35-45+ kts would be possible under strong to severe storms. Outside of precip, winds in the AM will be 5 - 10 kts for all stations. After 12 PM, winds S of Morgan's Point will pick up to 12 - 17 kts, while winds N of Morgan's Point remain at 5 - 10 kts. Winds outside of storms will be from the S throughout the day.

Temps: High temperatures Friday will be in the mid to upper 80s F near the Boarding Station. in the low 90s F for all other stations S of Morgan's Point, and in the mid 90s F for stations N of Morgan's Point.




Precip: Favoring dry conditions throughout the day Saturday.
