
INDIANA STATE FAIR Friday, August 4, 2023 6 PM Weather Forecast

Friday 8/4/23: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES (as of 6 PM ET, 8/4/23):

Precipitation:

- Continue to favor a dry forecast with any precipitation along a cold front likely remaining north.
- Watching as early as 8 AM tomorrow for light drizzle to work in with better timing towards 10 AM.

Temperatures:

 Temperatures will continue to decrease from the mid 80s to upper 70s towards the midnight hour.

Wind/Clouds:


- ✓ More sunshine than clouds will persist this afternoon, with increasing cloud cover to arrive towards 10 PM.
- ✓ Generally calm winds are expected today with a gradual shift from the northeast into the evening.

NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES (as of 6 PM ET, 8/4/23):

Precipitation:

- SAT: Confidence continues to remain lower with the progression of thunderstorm chances in the afternoon. Light drizzle as early as 8 AM with better window arriving 10 AM - 1PM. Scattered rain showers will then be possible 1 PM - 4 PM. Need to watch at the earliest 5 PM - 7 PM for lightning/strong to severe storm potential. Another wave of scattered strong storms possible 8 -11 PM (better chances than 5 PM wave). Within both windows, a very isolated/low-end chance for a brief tornado cannot be ruled out. Slightly better risk remains south of the fair.
- <u>SUN:</u> Scattered storms are expected to clear out in the AM (roughly by 8 AM). Isolated development possible in the afternoon but watching after 9 10 PM for storms and severe weather (winds, hail, and potential tornado possible). Again, primary risk is storms arrive later towards midnight or after into Monday morning.

Temperatures:

- High temperatures favored to get up to the mid to upper 80's F this weekend. Heat index values near 90 F will be possible throughout the weekend as well.
- Cooler weather anticipated into early next week.

Wind/Clouds:

- Winds outside of storms do not look to be a concern until Sunday-Monday, with occasional gusts of 20-30mph possible (especially Monday).
- The next 5 days will offer a mix of sunny / cloudy periods throughout each morning and afternoon.
