

Saturday 8/5/23: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES (as of 6 AM ET, 8/5/23):

Precipitation:

- ✓ Watching as early as 11 AM for light drizzle to work in with better timing towards 12 PM for light showers/drizzle from 12 - 4 PM. 5 -10 PM will be the best timeframe to watch for lightning threats in addition to an isolated strong to severe storm. While risk of tornadoes remains fairly low, it remains the primary hazard for today.
- ✓ Bulk of showers/storms exits by 11 PM with isolated coverage persisting through ~6 AM Sunday.

Temperatures:

- ✓ High temperatures tomorrow will be in the lower 80s, with Dew Points reaching the lower 70's by afternoon.
- ✓ Heat Index favored to reach 87 by 6PM, but highly dependent on ongoing shower/storm coverage.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Anticipating increasing clouds tonight with a mostly cloudy sky for tomorrow towards sunrise.
- ✓ Winds are anticipated to be 3-8 MPH during the AM from the E. A few gusts of 12-17 mph are possible towards 2 PM.

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

NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES (as of 6 AM ET, 8/5/23):

Precipitation:

- ✓ <u>SUN:</u> Scattered showers/storms are expected to clear out in the AM (roughly by 6 AM). Isolated development possible in the afternoon but watching after 11 PM (towards 1 AM MON) for storms and severe weather (winds, hail, and potential tornado possible). Again, primary risk is storms arrive later towards midnight or after into Monday morning.
- ✓ MON: Best severe threat will be ending towards 4 AM Monday with a brief drier period during the mid to late AM. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will be present for the afternoon with a low-end risk for a severe storm. At present the better risk for this looks to remain north. Rain chances exit towards 8 -10 PM.
- ✓ <u>TUE-WED:</u> Favoring mostly dry conditions outside of a few isolated popups during the afternoon on WED.

Temperatures:

- ✓ High temperatures favored to get up to the mid 80's F this weekend. Heat index values near 90 F will be possible throughout the weekend as well.
- Cooler weather anticipated into early next week, especially behind MON AM storms.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Winds outside of storms do not look to be a concern until Monday, with occasional gusts of 25-30 mph possible (especially into the PM)
- ✓ The next 5 days will offer a mix of sunny / cloudy periods throughout each morning and afternoon.
