
INDIANA STATE FAIR Wednesday, August 9, 2023 6 AM Weather Forecast

Wednesday 8/9/23: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES (as of 6 AM ET, 8/9/23):

Precipitation:

- ✓ A few very spotty light showers will be possible from ~11 AM 3 PM. Current thinking is that any storm activity would stay south.
- Around 4 PM, risks for storms arise out ahead of the "main" area of precipitation / storms (non-zero risk for stronger storms). "Main" wave is anticipated to get to the fairgrounds around 6 7 PM timeframe. This will offer up the greatest risk for wind gusts of 40 60 MPH winds. Main lightning risk lingers through ~9 PM.
- Some uncertainty exist on how long rain linger tonight. Currently favoring rain to linger through the overnight. Heavy rain/ flash flooding will be a concern as well.

Temperatures:

- ✓ High Temperatures today expected to get into the low 80's F in the afternoon today out ahead of evening storm activity.
- ✓ Heat Index approaching 85 F will be possible this afternoon.

Wind/Clouds:


- Clouds will be on the increase as we head throughout the day today.
- Outside of thunderstorms, a few wind gusts near 20 mph cannot be ruled out in the afternoon.

NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES (as of 6 AM ET, 8/9/23):

Precipitation:

- <u>THU:</u> Precipitation should exit after 4 5 AM THU AM. An isolated instance of a brief shower/ thunderstorm will be possible from roughly 6– 10 PM tomorrow evening along a trailing cold front.
- ✓ <u>FRI-SAT:</u> Lower confidence in terms of coverage but favoring at least low-end pop-up chances to be in play from 4-9PM on on Friday. Another front passes overnight FRI night into Saturday morning. Timing will need to be refined. Current thinking is for a dry SAT.
- ✓ <u>SUN-MON</u>: Need to watch for another widespread area of storms SUN night into MON. Stronger storms possible.

Temperatures:

- Friday-Sunday anticipating temp highs to be in the mid to upper 80's.
- ✓ Saturday remains the only day in the short term where Heat Indices may reach the low-tomid 90's by early afternoon.

Wind/Clouds:

- The next 5 days will offer a mix of sunny / cloudy periods throughout each morning and afternoon.
- ✓ Wind gusts do not look to be a concern outside of Sunday-Monday, with non-t-storm gusts of 15-25mph.
