




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring dry conditions with a very isolated chance for a shower within the 7-10 PM timeframe.


Wind: For the boarding station, winds will be out of the SE before shifting to out of the NE by 8 - 9 AM. After 9AM, winds will gradually veer until out of the S/SW for the rest of the day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 2-7kts through 12PM before increasing to 5-10kts the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point, winds will decrease to 2-7kts by 8 AM and remain there until 3 PM. After 3 PM, winds increase to 9-14 knots for the rest of the day.

High Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F. N of Morgan's Point: Upper 90s/Near 100 F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog issues at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Dry conditions anticipated Thursday morning with scattered showers/storms (20-30%) after 3 PM for stations primarily north of Morgan's Point. Storms capable of producing heavy downpours, lightning and isolated pockets of hail.

Wind: Winds will start out of the W/SW in the early morning before veering to out of the NW by 7 AM. After 2 PM, winds will gradually shift to being out of the SW by 5 PM and continue there the rest of the evening. Winds North of Morgan's Point will be 3-8 kts the entire day. Winds South of Morgan's Point will be 9-14 kts throughout the entire day outside of a slight decrease to 4-9kts from 11 AM – 3 PM. Storm related gusts likely reaching 40-50 MPH.






Precip: Dry conditions anticipated on Friday.


Wind: Winds will start out of the W/SW in the AM hours before shifting to being out of the SE at 12 PM. After 12 PM, winds will be out of the S/SE the rest of the day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 3-8 kts until 4 PM before increasing to 7-12 kts the rest of the day. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be 6-11 kts through 6 AM, then decrease to 3-8 kts until 4 PM. After 4 PM, winds increase to 8-13 kts the rest of the day.


