

Weather Headlines

- No tropical threats anticipated over the next 2 days. Monitoring tropical storm Idalia in the eastern Gulf of Mexico for middle of this week, however not favoring any impacts for HOU.
- Hit/miss showers/storms will be possible over the next 3 days
- Feels like temperatures of 105-110 F will be possible during the afternoon hours today, expecting temperatures to cool slightly in the early week.
 - Not anticipating any visibility concerns over the next 72 hours.






Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring dry conditions through 4 PM. Then after 4 PM, favoring hit/miss (20-30% chances) showers/storms to move into the area for the rest of the day.


Wind: Winds will start out of the W before becoming variable between 2-5 PM and settling out of the SW after 5 PM. Winds will then once again become variable after 8 PM, remaining that way for the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: 3-8 kts throughout the majority of the afternoon aside for a brief increase to 8-13 kts from 4-9 PM. S of Morgan's Point: 5-10 kts until 4 PM, then winds will increase to 12-17 kts through 9 PM. After 9 PM, favoring winds to calm to 2-7 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 25-30 kts will be possible under the strongest cells associated with today's activity.


Low Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Mid 85s F (Near Boarding Station), low/mid 80s F for all other stations. N of Morgan's Point: Low/Mid 80s F.


Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring a a 10% chance for isolated showers through 5 AM, before drier conditions move in through 9 AM. Then, anticipating hit/miss showers/storms to move in around 1 PM, lasting through 8 PM. After 8 PM, favoring dry conditions for the rest of the day.


Wind: Winds will be variable in direction throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: 2-7 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: 2-7 kts through 3 AM. After 3 AM, winds will increase to 8-13 kts through 8 PM. Then after 8 PM, winds will decrease to 2-7 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 25-30 kts will be possible under the strongest cells Monday.


High Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Low/Mid 90s F. N of Morgan's Point: Low 100s F.




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring scattered showers for all Stations S of Morgan's Point between 1-5 AM, then after 5 AM the Boarding Station will see continued isolated shower risks through 7 AM. Favoring dry conditions to move into the area after 11 AM.


Wind: Winds will be out of the ENE through 4 PM, when winds will shift out of the ESE for the remainder of the evening. N of Morgan's Point: 2-7 kts through 8 AM, increasing to 8-13 kts through 7 PM. Winds will return to 1-6 kts after 7 PM and remain at that clip for the rest of the evening. S of Morgan's Point: 8-13 kts through 5 PM, briefly increasing to 10-15 kts through 9 PM before decreasing to 2-7 kts for the remainder of the day.


High Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F. N of Morgan's Point: Upper 90s F.




