

Weather Headlines

- Anticipating dry conditions through Sunday.
- Excessive heat concerns (90+ F) to continue throughout at least next week.
- No active tropical threats to SE TX for next 7-10 days.
- Winds are primarily favored to remain calm, especially during the late morning / early afternoon hours (<10 kts) with speeds seldom exceeding 17 kts in the late PM over the next 72 hours. A few gusts of up to 20 kts are possible during the afternoon through Sunday.





American Model Low Pressure Tracks Next 10-Days




No tropical activity anticipated over the next 10 days for SE TX.




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring mostly dry conditions this morning, aside from an isolated (10%) chance of pop-up showers until 9 AM and an isolated chance of pop-up showers (10%) between 12-6 PM.


Wind: Winds will remain from the SSW for the whole day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 2-7 kts until 4 PM. After 4 PM, favoring winds to increase to 7-12 kts for the rest of the day. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be 7-12 kts before decreasing to 2-7 kts after 10 AM. Then after 2 PM, favoring winds S of Morgan's Point will increase to 12-17 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 15-20 kts will be possible for all stations after 5 PM Friday.


Temps: High temperatures today will be in the upper 90s to low 100s F N of Morgan's Point and in the upper 90s /low 100s S of Morgan's Point. The Boarding Station can expect temperatures in the upper 80s F.


Precip: Favoring dry conditions throughout the day Saturday.


Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SW throughout the day for all stations. For stations N of Morgan's Point, winds of 2–7 kts will continue through 5 PM. After 5 PM, favoring winds N of Morgan's Point to increase to 7-12 kts for the rest of the day. For Stations S of Morgan's Point winds will be at 10-15 kts through 9 AM, afterwinds will calm to 6–11 kts through 1 PM. After 1 PM winds will increase back to 12-17 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 15-20 kts will be possible for all stations after 5 PM Saturday.




Precip: Favoring dry conditions for the remainder of the day.


Wind: Winds will be out of the SW throughout the day. For Stations N of Morgan's Point winds will be 4-9kts until 6 PM. After 6 PM winds will increase to 8-13 kts for the rest of the day. Winds for Stations S of Morgan's Point will be 8-13 kts until 10 AM, after which time winds will calm to 4-9 kts until 3 PM. After 3 PM, winds will pick up to 12-17 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 15-20 kts are possible for all Station after 6 PM.

Temps: High temperatures Sunday will be in the upper 80s F for the Boarding Station, low/mid 90s F for all other Stations S of Morgan's Point and upper 90s/low 100s F N of Morgan's Point.


