





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions throughout the day today. A very low-end chance for an isolated shower will come between 12 - 7 PM (10%).

Wind: Winds will be from the SE for the entirety of the day. Winds north of Morgan's point will start out at 3-7 kts in the AM before increasing to 5-10 kts by 10 AM. Winds will then reach 7-12 kts from 3 PM - 8 PM before subsiding to 3-7 kts by 9 PM. Winds S of Morgan's Point will remain at 9-14 kts before increasing to 11-16 kts around 5 PM.


High Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 80s F. N of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F.


Visibility: No visibility concerns currently.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions on Thursday with a 10% chance for an isolated shower towards 2 PM. Chances then increase to 20% for a popup storm from 5 - 8 PM before chances dwindle for the overnight.

Wind: SE Winds will continue to diminish during the AM hours with winds north of Morgan's Point at 3 - 7 kts. Winds south of Morgan's Point will be at 4 - 9 kts by 10 AM. Winds across all stations will then pick up again towards 2 PM to 5 - 10 kts N of Morgan's Point and 6 -11 kts S of Morgan's Point. At sunset winds diminish back to 3 - 7 kts for stations north of Morgan's Point.




Visibility: Not anticipating any fog issues currently.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions Friday leading up until 9 AM where an isolated pocket (10%) of drizzle will be possible for the Boarding Station and 11/12. Then towards 4 PM chances increase to 20% for all stations until 7 PM. After 7 PM, rain chances exit.

Wind: Winds remain from the SE for Friday. Winds north of Morgan's Point will start at 3 -7 kts and increase to 5 - 10 kts in the afternoon. S of Morgan's Point will be steady at 7 - 12 kts for the entirety of the day.


Low Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 80s F. N of Morgan's Point: Mid 90s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any further visibility issues currently.

Wind Speed: 4 PM CT










- Will need to watch for elevated chances for rain/ storms next SUN to TUE although confidence is low at this distance (better coverage to the north). Above normal temperatures are expected in the meantime.
- Expecting below normal precipitation chances and above normal temperatures for the week 2 timeframe.
- Near normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks 3/4 timeframe.
