

### Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)



## Houston Pilots: Sat. 9/23/2023




### **Forecast Discussion**

**Precip:** A chance for a very isolated thunderstorm (5 - 10%) will be present through 7 PM. Favoring dry conditions beyond that time.


Wind: Winds are expected to remain out of the SSE through the entirety of the day. Winds gradually pick up into the afternoon/ evening becoming sustained around 10 - 15 knots for for all stations (windiest likely towards stations G/F). After sunset winds will become calm north of Morgan's point but will still be slightly elevated over open waters sustained around 8 - 13 knots will slightly shift more out of the SSW.


Low Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F. N of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 70s F.


#### **Forecast Discussion**

Precip: Favoring Sunday to be mostly dry, though a very low-end risk (5 – 10%) for isolated showers will be in play between 3-5 PM.


Wind: SSW winds gradually weaken through the AM becoming sustained around 7 – 12 knots by 6 AM for stations south of Morgan's Point. Like Saturday, winds will pick up into the afternoon and be more out of the south. By 5 PM, winds look to be sustained around 10 - 15 knots for all stations (windiest over open waters). After sunset, winds will start to subside for stations north of Morgan's Point while remaining slightly elevated for stations south around 7 – 12 knots by 11 PM.




#### Precip Image: 3 PM CT

## Houston Pilots: Mon. 9/25/2023




#### **Forecast Discussion**

Precip: An approaching cold front will bring chances on Monday, but confidence is low on exact timing of precipitation chances. Currently favoring at least isolated chances after 1 PM with scattered potential after 4 PM. Adjustments will be likely to this has more data comes in.

Wind: Winds are expected to weaken through MON AM likely becoming 3 - 7 knots sustained for all stations by 9 AM with a gradual shift from the SW. Winds will pick up slightly into the afternoon around 6 - 12 knots and shift more out of the SSE.



## Houston Pilots: 9/23/23





- The cold front mentioned on the MON slide will hang around the area providing for sporadic chances next week. Scattered chances will be slightly better into next weekend, although significant rainfall is not expected.
- Expecting slightly below normal precipitation chances and above normal temperatures for the week
  2 timeframe.
- Above normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> timeframe.
