



Forecast Discussion

Precip: While lower confidence remains in today's forecast, additional "waves" of storms are expected to be possible today from around 8 AM - 12 PM, as well as from roughly 2 PM - 10 PM. The risk to the morning wave is that it arrives later near 11 AM in the 8 - 12 AM timeframe. These storms will also have the potential to produce wind gusts of 30 -35 kts mainly the afternoon wave.

Wind: The above storm systems makes for a tricky wind forecast as well, as these storm systems will impact wind direction/ speeds. Any storms that pass can shift the winds more out of the north in their wake. Outside of storm induced wind shifts. southerly winds are expected to weaken into the AM around 3 - 8 knots for stations south of Morgan's Point by 8 AM with lighter winds to the north. Afternoon winds south of Morgan's point generally remain in the 3-8 kt range, with occasional pulses of 5-10 kt winds. Winds likely start to become variable/light as a cold front approaches towards the 10 PM timeframe.





Forecast Discussion

Precip: A cold front lingering around the HOU area will keep minor precipitation chances at play into TUE although the exact placement of where this front will be remains somewhat uncertain. Favoring spotty showers to hug the coastline for most of the day. Severe weather is not favored, and rain chances will be at 30 - 40% quite consistently. The best window for a lull in coverage will be from 4 - 9 AM.


Wind: Early TUE morning, a cold front is expected to pass which will usher in NE winds sustained around 3 – 7 kts Winds are expected to gradually shift back out of the SE into the afternoon towards 1-2 PM. After this wind shift, winds will range at 3 - 8 kts across all stations.





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered shower chances (20-30%) will be in play for the Boarding Station throughout the AM. These chances will then move on-shore towards 1 PM and be in play for all stations through 6 PM. Favoring dry conditions beyond this time.

Wind: Winds will be from the NE during the AM hours, veering SE by 3 PM. Winds for most Stations be generally calm at 1-6 kts throughout the day. Towards 11 AM winds will increase to 4 - 9 kts across all stations. Winds then calm to 3 -7 kts after sunset.





Wind Speed: 3 PM CT










- ➤ The cold front mentioned on the MON slide will hang around the area providing for sporadic chances through Friday. 11/12 and the Boarding Station will be in better position to see spotty shower chances. Current thinking is the pattern starts to dry out heading into the weekend. Temperatures will remain above normal.
- ➤ Generally drier/ warmer than average temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- Above normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
