

- Not anticipating tropical development in the Gulf of Mexico over the next 7-10 days.
- Majority of rain chances over the next 2 3 days secluded S of 11/12 and near the Boarding Station.
- Elevated winds of 13-18 kts will persist over the next 2 – 3 days for Stations S of Morgan's Point
- Not anticipating any visibility concerns over the next few days.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Stations S of 25/26 will have low-end isolated shower chances (10%) through 4 PM. Favoring dry conditions for all other stations throughout the day.

Wind: Winds will be out of the East throughout the day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 6-11 kts through 7 PM, before returning to 1-6 kts and remaining at that clip for the remainder of the day. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be 13-18 kts throughout the day with gusts up to 22 kts.

Low Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F. N of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility issues currently.




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Stations S of 11/12 will see low-end isolated shower chances (10-20%) starting at 12 PM. Favoring dry conditions for all other stations throughout the day.

Wind: Winds are expected to remain out of the SE/ESE throughout the day. For Stations N of Morgan's Point, winds will begin the day relatively calm at 2-7 kts but will gradually increase to 7-12 kts by 1 PM and will return to 2-7 kts by 7 PM. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be 13-18 kts throughout the day.


High Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F. N of Morgan's Point: Mid 90s F.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Stations S of 11/12 will see low-end isolated shower chances (10-20%) through 12 PM. After this time, shower chances will move ashore and be in play for all Stations throughout the remainder of the day.


Wind: Winds will be out of the ESE throughout the day. For Stations N of Morgan's Point, winds will begin the day relatively calm at 2-7 kts but will gradually increase to 7-12 kts by 10 AM and will decrease to 3-8 kts by 9 PM. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be 13-18 kts throughout the day. Gusts reaching 20 kts will be possible near the Boarding Station.


High Temps: S of Morgan's Point: Low 90s/High 80s F. N of Morgan's Point: Mid 90s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility issues at this time.






High Temps Tuesday

Houston Pilots: 10/1/23





- Isolated chances continue today for the Boarding Station with the pattern remaining fairly dry getting into the beginning of the week. Temperatures will remain above normal.
- Generally drier/slightly colder than average temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
