

Houston Pilots Wind Chart









Precip: Favoring conditions to remain dry for the remainder of the afternoon and evening.





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring shower/storms to work into the area starting at 2 AM Monday morning and expect these chances (30-40%) to continue until 6 AM, however risk is that better coverage will remain to the W. After 6 AM only spotty (10%) drizzle will remain, lasting until 5 PM.

Wind: Anticipating winds out of the SSE to SE throughout the day Monday. For Stations N of Morgan's Point, winds will be at 4 - 9 kts through 12 PM before increasing to 6-11 kts the rest of the day. For stations S of Morgan's Point winds will 4 - 9 kts before winds speeds increase at 1 PM to 8 - 13 kts by 12 PM and remain that way for the rest of the evening.






Precip: Favoring dry conditions throughout the day Tuesday as rain chances remain to the west.

Wind: Winds will become out of the SE throughout the day Tuesday. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 13-18 kts and remain that way all day. Before 5 AM winds will be 14-19 kts near the boarding station. S of Morgan's Point will be at 12-17 kts throughout the entire day. Wind gusts North of Morgan's Point the in the afternoon can range from 25 - 28 kts through 5 PM.


