

## **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** A few isolated showers (10-20%) will be possible from 11 AM - 5 PM. Outside of this window, favoring the day to be dry.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SSW. N of Morgan's Point: 3-8 kts through 10 AM before an increase to 7 - 12 kts before decreasing at 6 PM again to 4-9 kts for the remainder of the evening. S of Morgan's Point: 3-8 kts through the AM hours with a slight increase to 8-13 kts after 12 PM. A few wind gusts of 13-18 kts will be possible at all stations between 1-6 PM CT.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80's F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid-Upper 70s F.


Visibility: Fog development is not favored to impact stations this morning.

## **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions aside from low end chance (10-20%) of showers between 10 AM – 3 PM.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SSE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: 3-8 kts throughout the AM with an increase to 5-10 kts after 3 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 3-8 kts through 3 PM before increasing to 7-12 kts throughout the day on Wednesday.













#### **Next 7 Day Temperature Departure**









#### **8-14** Day Temperature Departure

- ➢ High pressure settles in the HOU area keeping drier conditions over the next few days. Better rain chances expected to return Thursday with a cold front on Friday. Warmer temperatures returning into the weekend, putting week 1 temps above normal.
- ➤ Much above normal rainfall and slightly above normal temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- Seasonal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> timeframe.
