

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring a 20% chance of light/isolated showers through 8 PM followed by dry conditions after that time.

Wind: Winds from the SE for the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: 5-10 kts through 5 PM. Winds will calm to 3-8 kts after this time. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 7-12 kts for the remainder of the day. Towards 6 PM winds calm to 3 - 8 kts with the Boarding Station remaining at 7 - 12 kts.

Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s-Near 70 F.

Visibility: No visibility concerns for the rest of the day


HRRR | 10-meter Wind Speed [mph] & Direction



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Pockets of isolated drizzle (10-20%) will start near sunrise. Any moisture in the AM is favored to remain light in nature. Towards 12 PM, coverage will become hit/miss at 40% through 5 PM, before drizzle tapers off by 7 PM.

Wind: Winds will be from the S on Monday, with a shift from the W late in the evening after the front pushes through ~6 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will start at 3-8 kts with an increase to 10 - 15 kts from 11 AM -4 PM. After 4 PM winds return to 3-8 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 5-10 kts through 11 AM before increasing to 12-17 kts. Winds will then decrease back to 5-10 kts after 6 PM. Boarding station winds will remain at 12 - 17 kts. Gusts of 21-24 kts at the Boarding Station from 2-5 PM.






Precip: Conditions will become cooler and drier after the cold front passes on MON. Favoring dry conditions throughout the day.

Wind: Winds will be out of the NW throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 9-14 kts throughout much the day, decreasing to 5 - 10 kts after 9 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 14-19 kts throughout the day. Winds at the Boarding station a touch higher at 17 - 22 kts. Gusts of 21-24 kts possible across all stations after 11 AM, with the Boarding station at 24 - 28 kts.


High Temps: Notably cooler behind the cold front. N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.


















- > Today and MON presenting rain chances via two cold fronts. Anticipating seasonable to slightly above normal temps for this upcoming week.
