

Weather Headlines

- Favoring dry conditions over the next couple days with next chance for rain returning THU. Active pattern remains into the weekend with rain chances.
- Not anticipating any fog concerns over the next few days outside of a low-end risk on Wednesday.
- Keeping an eye on increasing wave heights for Thursday with 4-5 ft in play for the Boarding Station in the AM, and potentially 6 7 ft waves by the evening hours.



Visibility can be slightly reduced in here, but favored to remain above 3 miles



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Dry conditions throughout the day.

Wind: Winds will slowly veer in the AM starting from the NE to E by 2PM, then being out of the SE by 6 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will sit at 3 – 8 kts throughout the day, calming to 1 - 5 kts as winds shift SE after 6 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will continue at 12-17 kts through 12 PM before decreasing to 5-10 kts by 3 PM.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near 60 F to lower 60s F . S of Morgan's Point: Upper 50's near 60 F.


Visibility: No visibility concerns for Tuesday.




Precip: Dry conditions are favored to persist on Wednesday,


Wind: Winds out of the E/SE will eventually have a SE favorability by 1 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be near calm at 2-5 kts throughout the AM, increasing to 5 - 10 kts after 12 PM. S of Morgan's Point: 3-8 kts through 12 PM, increasing to 7-12 kts for the remainder of the day.


High Temps: Slightly warmer. N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.


Visibility: Very low-end risk for fog to sit SW of Morgan's Point and west of 11/12. Low level moisture does not look impressive to see fog form, but timing to watch will be from 3 - 8 AM CT. Visibility expected to remain above 3 miles.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Scattered light/moderate rain showers to begin as early as 3 AM THU and gradually increase in coverage before becoming widespread moderate/heavy rain for the PM hours (60% chances in the PM). Monitoring a low-end severe risk where gusty winds in the late AM/early PM under storms can produce wind gusts of up to 32 - 37 kts


Wind: Winds will be out of the SE for the majority of THU before shifting to out of the S/SW by 9 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Sustained at 6-11 kts through 8 AM before increasing to 11-16 kts the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will start at 10-15 kts before increasing to 17-22 kts by 9 AM. Winds then increasing again by 3 PM to 20-25 kts through 9 PM before decreasing to back to 17-22 kts. Wind gusts of 30-35 kts will be possible after 12 PM.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Near 70 F.



Visibility: No fog concerns, however areas of reduced visibility possible THU PM under heavier downpours.


Precip Image: 3 PM CT



Wind Speed: 4 PM CT





- > Above normal rainfall and above normal temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- Seasonal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
