



Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report






Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)



Forecast Discussion

Precip: Dry conditions are favored throughout the day today.


HRRR | 10-meter Wind Speed [mph] & Direction

Wind: Winds out of the E/SE will shift out of the SE by 12 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 3-8 kts throughout the AM, increasing to 5 - 10 kts after 12 PM. S of Morgan's Point: 8 - 13 kts through 12 PM, increasing to 10 – 15 kts through 7 PM then to 13 – 18 kts for the remainder of the day. Occasional gusts of up to 20 kts will be possible before 6PM with gusts reaching 20 - 25 kts after 6 PM, especially for the Boarding Station.


High Temps: Slightly warmer. N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.


Visibility: Patchy fog is present this AM N. and W. of the stations. Not anticipating this fog to be a visibility risk to any of the stations this morning.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers and thunderstorms begin to work in as early as 3 AM THU and gradually increase in coverage before becoming widespread moderate/heavy after 8AM-CT and through the early afternoon. Monitoring a severe risk where gusty winds in the late AM / early PM under storms can produce wind gusts of 35-40kts. Low end risk for iso hail and tornadoes.


Wind: Winds will be out of the SE/SSE for the majority of THU before shifting to out of the S/SW by 9 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Sustained at 5-10 kts through 9 AM before increasing to 11-16 kts the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will start at 11-16 kts before increasing to 15-20 kts by 7 AM. Winds then increasing again by 12 PM to 23 - 27 kts through 9 PM before decreasing to 18-23 kts. Wind gusts of 35-40 kts will be possible after 12 PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Near 70 F.

Visibility: No fog concerns, however areas of reduced visibility possible THU under heavier downpours.

Houston Pilots: Fri. 12/01/2023




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Showers will continue throughout the morning and linger S of Morgan's Point through 2 PM CT. Favoring a brief dry period before isolated (20-30%) chances of showers between 8 PM - 12 AM CT.

Wind: Winds will start out of the NW before slowly shifting to the be out of the NE by the end of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will briefly be 7 – 12 kts through 3 AM before decreasing to 3-8 kts for the remainder of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will ne 12 - 17 kts through 5 AM before decreasing to 4-9kts for the rest of the day.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: High 60's F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to Upper 60's F










High Temps Friday

- Next organized system looks to enter early Thursday AM and exit Friday. An active weekend with rain chances look to persist. Colder than normal weather is expected this week following the last cold front.
- Slightly below normal rainfall and above normal temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- Seasonal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
