



Weather Headlines

- Scattered showers/storms expected to continue through the day. Severe weather risks will hang around until ~5 PM. Gusts of 40 - 50 kts can't be ruled out under the strongest storms, with the Boarding Station being at the greatest risk.
- Max wave heights increase for this evening with heights up to 5 7' for the Boarding Station.
- Anticipating patchy to widespread fog to develop this PM with visibility risks continuing through the AM.



Houston Pilots Wave Height Update






Significant Wave Height Image



3 PM CST Thursday Afternoon The top image shows wave heights around 3 PM CST for this afternoon. Wave heights will slightly increase throughout the afternoon, with best potential for Boarding Station to see locally 5 – 7' max wave height between 3PM – 9 PM.

Heights are not expected to exceed 3 feet for any other station S of Morgan's Point aside from 11/12 with 3 – 5' and the Boarding Station. Max wave heights will gradually die down after 9PM.






THREAT

- Lower confidence exists at this time, however watching for patchy, dense fog development behind the storms moving through this afternoon as a front looks to stall along the coastline. Patchy fog development could begin as early as 11 PM tonight decreasing visibility to 1 3 miles.
- Fog coverage would then increase throughout the early morning hours of Friday, becoming the most widespread and dense between 5 11 AM, reducing visibilities to 1 mile or less.
- Watching for the risk of this fog lingering in the Bay for stations S. of Morgan's Point into the afternoon with the risk being possible until 10 PM Fri.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered to widespread showers and T-storms are expected to continue through 7 PM-CT (70%). The heaviest downpours will continue to set up over the Boarding Station. After 7 PM, 30% chances continue through 10 PM before rain finally pushes out of the area. Monitoring a continued severe risk due to strong wind gusts up to 50 kts, tornado potential and a low end hail threat.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE/SSE for the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Sustained at 15-20 kts until 6 PM with the rest of the day sitting around 5 – 10 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds 18-23 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 35-45 kts will be possible after through the afternoon (independent of strong storms).


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to Upper 60s F.


Visibility: Watching for patchy to potentially widespread fog development behind the storms this evening. More details found on the visibility report above.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Showers / iso storms (30 – 40%) will push in at 10 AM Friday before coverage increases around 12 - 6PM (60%). Favoring rain to taper off, becoming isolated (20-30%) with showers between 6 PM - 12 AM CT.

Wind: Winds will start out of the NW before slowly shifting to the be out of the NE by the end of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will briefly be 7 – 12 kts through 3 AM before decreasing to 3-8 kts for the remainder of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 12 – 17 kts through 5 AM before decreasing to 4-9kts for the rest of the day. Gusts of 20-25 kts embedded in storms cannot be ruled out.




Visibility: Patchy to widespread fog expected through the AM with a low end threat for patchy fog to continue for stations S of Morgan's Point into the PM.


Precip: Dry conditions are favored throughout the day, aside from drizzle chances (10%) through 4AM-CT.

Wind: Winds out of the NE through most of Saturday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 3 - 6 kts for all of Saturday. S of Morgan's Point: winds will be 10 - 15 kts through the entirety of the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Lower 70's F S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating visibility concerns for Saturday morning given slightly elevated winds.

Wind Speed: 8 AM CT










- Above normal rainfall and above normal temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- Seasonal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ¾ timeframe.
