



Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring Dry Conditions for today.

Wind: By 4 PM, winds settle in from the SW for the remaining afternoon hours. N of Morgan's Point: Sustained at 2 – 6 kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds 5 - 10 kts consistently. The Boarding Station 7 - 12 kts through the evening.

Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 50s F S of Morgan's Point: Mid-upper 50s F.

Visibility: No visibility concerns favored for Sunday





Forecast Discussion

Precip: Dry conditions in store for Monday. A dry cold front will swing through around 4 - 7 AM.


Wind: SW winds from Sunday evening will veer clockwise from the NW again as the front progresses through. Winds then settle from the north by 7 AM and remain from the N for the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: 3 - 7 kts ahead of the front, after 7 AM winds increase to 4 - 9 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be on an increasing trend, from 5 - 10 kts at 12 AM to 12 - 17 kts by 5 AM. As the front passes, winds will be 15 - 20 kts (7 -10 AM). After 10 AM winds slowly decrease to 7-12 kts by 2 PM, then 5-10 kts by 5 PM (winds remain at 7-12 kts for Boarding Station. Gusts can reach 23 - 27 kts at the Boarding Station from 7 -**10 AM**



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions into Tuesday.

Wind: Northerly winds will become more NNE towards 2 PM, then NE by 11 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 3 - 7 kts. S of Morgan's Point: 6 - 11 kts prior to 8 AM. Near calm winds will follow at 3 - 7 kts after 8 AM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s F to near 70 F S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.



Wind Speed: 7 AM CT









