

- A few showers and isolated storms possible Friday. Strong storms chances arrive Saturday PM as cold front pushes southeast. Keeping an eye on strong/severe potential with these storms.
- Watching for a patchy fog development within the bay late Friday into Saturday ahead of the front.
- A few wind gusts up to 20 kts will be possible this evening.


Keeping an eye on the potential for patchy / patchy dense fog
development in the Bay late Friday night into Saturday morning our
ahead of the cold front as winds will be out of the SE prior.

- Patchy fog could begin to develop around 11 PM-CT Friday with coverage becoming the most "widespread" between 2 AM-CT and 6 AM-CT. Between 6 AM – 11 AM-CT, coverage would then begin to once again become patchier in nature.
- Fog development would begin in the interior portion of the bay near Morgan's Point with coverage extending toward Station 11/12 through the early AM.
- > Favoring fog risk to end after 11-12 PM-CT Saturday.

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Dry conditions favored throughout the rest of the day.


Wind: Winds out of the SE throughout the evening. N of Morgan's Point: Winds currently at 8 – 12 kts, then after 5 PM winds will decrease to 5-10 kts and remain there for the rest of the PM. S of Morgan's Point: 10 - 15 kts throughout the day (most consistently 15 kts towards the Boarding Station). Gusts of 18-20 kts possible through the evening.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near to Low 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns the rest of the day.

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Favoring mostly dry conditions, with low end risks for light showers and a few isolated storms between 8 AM and 5PM CT.


Wind: Calm and variable winds are expected through the AM hours before increasing during the afternoon / evening as front approaches out of the southeast. N of Morgan's Point: Winds to start at 4 - 8 kts, becoming 10 - 14 kts after 2PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds to start at 5 - 9 kts, becoming 12 - 16kts after 12PM. Winds towards the boarding station will reach 13 - 18 kts after 12PM, increasing to 14 - 19 kts by 6PM. Gusts of 20-30 kts will be possible throughout the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F S of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 60s F.

**Visibility:** Watching the risk for patchy fog development in the bay late Friday around **11PM** into Sat. AM out ahead of the front this weekend. Lower confidence at this time, however based on latest model guidance, would favor this fog to set up closer to Morgan's Point. View visibility slide for more details.

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Hit/miss shower chances (20-30%) will be in play through 7 AM. A lull in precip will follow until 12 PM, when more widespread (60-70%) chances for storms (with severe potential including gusty winds and hail) move in from the NW and remain for the rest of the day.

Wind: Winds out of the S/WSW through 5 PM, veering out of the NW after this time as the main front arrives. N of Morgan's Point: Sustained at 5 – 10 kts prior to 6 PM, then 9 – 14 kts for the remainder of the evening as the front arrives. S of Morgan's Point: 10-15 kts through 4 AM, decreasing to 8-13 at this time and remaining at this speed through 7 PM. After 7 PM, winds steadily increase to 20-25 kts by 12 AM. Gusts through the AM will be around 25-30 kts, increasing to 35-45 kts moving into the late evening.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70 F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 70s F.


Visibility: Watching the early AM for a potential fog development within the Bay associated with the front. Risk would last until ~12 PM. More details on fog slide above.

Wind Speed: 9 PM CT



### Houston Pilots: 12/7/23





- Next best shot at rain will be on the 9<sup>th</sup> via a cold front. Seasonable / slightly warmer than normal weather is expected this week.
- Above normal rainfall and slightly below normal temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> timeframe.
