

## **Weather Headlines**

- Wind gusts will continue a subsiding trend this afternoon. Check the Day 1 slide and wind slide below for more details.
- Due to the strong NW winds today, lower water levels are present across the Bay. Waters can look to fill again once winds flip from the E/SE midday Monday.
- Monday and Tuesday AM hold calm winds of <15 kts.</li>
   Winds begin to pick back up to 15 -20 Tuesday PM.
- Drier pattern ahead behind this AM's cold front. Next rain chances would not enter until Friday.
- Not favoring any visibility issues over the coming days for fog.




## **Houston Pilots Wave Height Update**

The top image shows wave heights around 3 PM CT this afternoon. Water levels across the Bay will be receding as NW winds push waters out to sea. Peak heights of 2 -3 feet can be anticipated at the Boarding Station.

Waters will calm significantly into the late evening/early AM on Monday. Wave heights will be less than 3 feet Monday AM. Shown on the bottom is heights at 3 AM.

## **Houston Pilots Wind Chart**





## **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Dry conditions favored throughout the day after hit/miss showers move out of the area by 3 AM CT.

Wind: NNW winds continue for this afternoon and evening. Winds across all stations will be on a slow decreasing trend for the PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds start at 8 - 12 kts, calming to 3 - 8 kts by 7 PM. S of Morgan's Point: 18 -23 kts to start the afternoon at 2 PM, subsiding to 12 - 17 kts by 5 PM and will then slowly weaken to 6 - 10 kts by midnight. Wind gusts of up to 22 - 26 kts will be possible through 4 PM mainly south of Morgan's Point. A few gusts to 20 kts can linger at the Boarding Station as late as 7 PM.



## **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions for Monday

Wind: Winds will start out from the NW through 2 AM before veering to be out of the SE by 12 PM and remain there the rest of Monday (winds slowly veer clockwise) N of Morgan's Point: 3 - 8 kts prior to 2 AM, then 2 - 6 kts afterwards. S of Morgan's Point: Winds of 3 - 8 kts through 4 PM. 5 - 10 kts after 4 PM.





## **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions throughout the day on Tuesday.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE through 4 AM TUE before shifting to out of the E for the remainder of the day. N of Morgan's Point: 4-9 kts through 10 AM before increasing to 7-12 kts for the rest of Tuesday. S of Morgan's Point: 7-12 kts through 10 AM, then increasing to 12-17 kts by 3 PM and continuing there the rest of the day (winds will be slightly higher near the Boarding Station at 15 -20 kts post 3 PM). Gusts of 20-25 kts will be possible after 12 PM S of Morgan's Point.



- Seasonal precipitation chances and temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- ➤ Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ¾ timeframe.
