



- Heavy rain /gusty wind risks will end after tonight, as front pushes fully through the region!






Dense fog is expected to continue across Galv. Bay through ~6 PM-CT today before fog begins to retreat back towards the Gulf. Stations N. of Morgan's Point seeing misty conditions with visibility at 6 – 8 miles.

From 6 – 9 PM-CT, anticipating fog to be patchier in nature with visibility reduced to 2 – 4 miles for Station 51/52 to Station 11/12. The Boarding Station however will still be at risk of visibility at less than 1 mile as front stalls over the Gulf.

After 9 PM, expecting fog to clear out across all stations outside of the Boarding Station which will likely still see dense fog with less than 0.5 mile visibility through around 3-4 AM-CT before fog pulls far enough south to leave visibility improved for all stations.

#### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Spotty showers expected to continue across the area through 3 PM (60%), with coverage for scattered showers and T-storms picking up after 3 PM, lasting until ~9-10 PM-CT before clearing out for the rest of the night. A few stronger storms with gusts up to 30 kts possible under a stronger cell.


Wind: Winds will be variable through 3 PM, then winds will push out of the N/NE with the front. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 5 – 10 kts will gradually increase after 3 PM to 10-15 kts for the rest of the evening. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 10 – 15 throughout the rest of the evening with 18-23 kts gusts picking up across all stations after 3 PM today.



#### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Dry conditions are favored throughout the day, aside from drizzle chances (20%) between 2PM and 5PM.

Wind: Winds out of the NE /NNE through most of Saturday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 3 - 7 kts for all of Saturday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 10 – 15 kts through 11AM before slightly decreasing to 8 – 13 kts for the remainder of the day.






#### **Forecast Discussion**

**Precip:** Favoring Dry Conditions for Sunday.

Wind: Winds will be fairly calm and variable given the passage of a weak front during the morning hours before increasing out of the west after 8PM. N of Morgan's Point: Sustained at 2 – 6 kts kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds 7 – 10 kts through 5AM before becoming 3 – 6 kts for the rest of the day. After 10 PM as winds shift out of the west, winds of 8 – 13 kts are expected through Monday AM.










High Temps Sunday

## Houston Pilots: 12/1/23





- Fairly active start to weekend with rain chances to continue intermittently throughout the period, but beyond Friday not favoring additional heavy rain risks. Warmer than normal weather is expected this week following the last cold front.
- > Above normal rainfall and above normal temperatures are expected into the week 2 timeframe.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> timeframe.
