





Houston Pilots Wave Height Update






Significant Wave Height Image



9 AM CST Friday

The top image shows wave heights around 9 AM CT this morning. Max wave heights for the Boarding Station and 11/12 of 5 - 7 ft will continue through early this afternoon. After reaching their peak height, waves will gradually begin a slow decrease through the weekend



6 PM CST Friday

The bottom images shows wave heights around 6 PM CT this evening. Max wave heights for the Boarding Station and 11/12 will slightly drop to 4 – 6 ft, but will continue to linger above 3 ft through SAT PM.

Houston Pilots Wind Chart





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Low end chances (10%) for scattered showers during the AM hours. Scattered Pockets of Heavy Rain / Storms possible after 6 PM with storm front arriving shortly after midnight / early Saturday AM.

Wind: Winds will continue to remain out of the E through 8PM before veering out of the ESE prior to arrival of front. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 4-9 kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: 10 - 15 kts for the entire day, with winds of 13-18 kts at 11/12 and the Boarding Station. Gusts of up to 22 kts North of Morgan's Point and up to 22 - 26 kts at 11/12 and the Boarding Station. Localized Storm Gusts of up to 35kts can't be ruled out for all locations.




Visibility: Not favoring sea fog concerns at this point given timing of front, however heavy rainfall in the late PM may reduce visibilities at times.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered pockets of moderate to heavy showers/some storms will move out with the front as it moves past the area after 5AM, with (20%) chances continuing through 9AM.

Wind: Winds will be variable and range from 5 - 10 kts for all locations as the front passes through about 2AM and then veer out of the N - NNE. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will increase to 8 - 12 kts by 5AM and continue that way for the remainder of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will increase to 10 -15 kts by 5AM and continue that way for the remainder of the day. For the Boarding Station, winds of 13 - 18 kts will be possible between 10AM and 4PM, with localized gusts of up to 22 kts.





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions throughout Sunday.

Wind: Winds will remain out of the N through much of the day SUN but will shift out of the NW near 6 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 3-8 kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 10-15 kts will gradually decrease through the morning, setting at 3-8 kts by 2 PM.





Wind Speed: 5 AM CT









- ➤ Below normal temperatures and slightly above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³⁄₄ timeframe.
