Weather Headlines

- The quiet pattern continues through New Year's Eve before the next rain chance enters on New Year's Day (MON). Additional chances coming Tuesday night into Wednesday.
- Monitoring potential for fog during the morning on Monday. Greatest risk will be for stations 51/52 and S.
- Winds remain generally calm today, but will pick up with the arrival of rain MON and TUE







As winds remain generally calm through early MON AM, brief reduced visibilities of of less than one mile will be possible for stations S of 51/52 and N of the boarding station.

- While low-end fog potential will begin at 2AM-CT the greatest risk will between 7AM – 9AM CT Mon.
- After 10 AM, winds will increase over the bay and work to remove and limit any further fog potential throughout the late morning.




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring dry conditions for today, aside from some isolated showers (20%-30%) showers after 7:00PM near the boarding station.

Wind: SSW winds to continue for much of Sunday, veering out of the SSE by 6 PM. N Morgan's Point: 3-7 kts outside of a window from 1 - 4 PM at 5 - 10 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be calm briefly to 1-5 kts between through 2PM. After 2PM winds pickup to 5 - 10 kts and remain at that speed for the rest of the day.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 50s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers will build in along a front just after midnight towards 2 AM. Best window for rainfall will be from 4 - 11 AM. Dry conditions are favored after 11 AM. Chance of rain is 20% - 30 %

Wind: S/SE winds will veer clockwise with the arrival of the front, settling out of the NNE by 9 AM. Winds become NE by 10 PM. N Morgan's Point: 2-7 kts through 7 AM, at which time winds will increase to 5-10 kts and will remain at that clip for the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: 4 - 9 kts through 9 AM, increasing to 7 -12 kts at that time. Winds near the Boarding Station will be 8-14 kts after 3 PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low to mid 60s F.


Visibility: Patchy dense fog will be possible starting at 2AM and continuing through 10AM. Greatest risk of fog will be between 7 – 10 AM.


Precip: Dry conditions for the morning and early-mid afternoon. Scattered showers will then build in from the SW near 5 PM and persist for the remainder of the evening.


Wind: Winds out of the E/ENE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: 4-9 kts through 5 PM, increasing to 7-12 kts with the arrival of rain. S of Morgan's Point: 8-13 kts before 5 PM, increasing to 10-15 kts at that time. 15-20 kts winds at the Boarding Station.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 50s Near 60 F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid-Upper 50s/low 60s F.

Visibility: No visibility concerns for Tuesday. Downpours can cause visibility to drop to ~2 miles at times.

Precip Image: 7 PM CT








High Temps Tuesday

- Expecting the next rain chance moving in Monday AM and an all day event of rain on Wednesday. Below normal temperatures are favored over the next week.
- Cooler temperatures and above normal rainfall is favored for the week 2 timeframe
- Below normal temperatures and seasonal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
