Light drizzle/ wet surfaces expected today/ this evening into SAT AM.

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

NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES:

Precipitation:

- ✓ <u>FRI:</u> Light moisture will be possible at any one point today, with the best opportunity in the 2 PM 9 PM window. Amounts should be about 0.1" or less.
- ✓ <u>SAT:</u> Drizzle risks continue to remain on Saturday. Confidence is lower on exact coverage / timing. However, enough low-level moisture is present combined with wind flow off the lake to keep this at play at any point. Drizzle can mix in with fog at times as well.
- ✓ <u>SUN</u>: Drizzle risks/ fog risks can continue through SUN AM. SUN PM is expected to be dry.
- ✓ <u>MON/TUE:</u> Data is picking up on a weak quick moving system to move through MON/TUE. Rainfall amounts look minor but will offer up additional chances of moisture, nonetheless. Timing would be late Monday night into TUE at this distance.
- ✓ <u>WED</u>: Most of WED should be dry. However, some lingering pockets of drizzle cannot be ruled out in the AM.

Temperatures:

- ✓ A gradual warmer trend is expected into next week as we move out of the recent cold snap.
- ✓ High temperatures into the upper 30's F to lower 40's F are expected.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Additional rounds of fog will be possible through SAT AM, especially after 6 PM tonight.
- ✓ Fog threats can linger though SAT into SUN AM as well.
- ✓ Clouds will be plentiful through the weekend.
- ✓ More peaks of sun will be possible into early next week. However, with incoming weak system, an increase in clouds is still expected.
