Weather Headlines

- Dry conditions favored this morning, however scattered showers expected to return this afternoon with heavy rainfall beginning MON.
- Winds expected to increase later this morning. They will become quite elevated this evening Monday early PM
- A Zulu port condition has been issued due to anticipated wave heights to reach near 6 ft starting towards 6 PM CT SUN.

- While no visibility concerns are favored for the remainder of the weekend, Sea fog threats look possible starting TUE/WED with numerous shots of showers/thunderstorms. Low confidence exists if sea fog can be observed due to heavy rain and gusty winds helping to mix the atmosphere. Nonetheless, the "ingredients" are still present for sea fog risks

➤ Please view the following slide for a visual representation regarding increasing wave heights tomorrow during the early afternoon. 4–5-foot waves can start to develop near 6 AM CT this morning. Waves would not start reaching the 6-foot threshold until roughly 6 PM in the afternoon but note the risk time would be 3 PM CT at the earliest to see an occasional 6 -ft swell.

12 hours prior to predicted sustained winds of 34+ KTS or 6' wave height


- From 6 PM today 3 PM MON waves will be capable of exceeding 6 ft. Peak waves will occur near 9 AM MON 3 PM MON before waves start to decline into the afternoon/evening
- > Favoring waves to be 4 -6 ft by 9 PM ET Monday evening. With heights of <6 ft after midnight Tuesday.






Significant Wave Height Image

Wave heights will continue to increase throughout the late morning and into the afternoon. Earliest chances of seeing 6ft waves would be by 3PM-CT with waves reaching 5-7ft by 6PM.

Wave heights will continue to increase into the evening and early Monday morning, with peak waves reaching from 9 AM MON – 6 PM CT. Wave heights during this time can peak at 6 - 8 feet, with a few swells to 9 ft. Waves then begin a weakening process PM MON and becoming below 6 ft after 12 AM CT TUE.




Houston Pilots Wind Chart

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered shower/drizzle will continue to be possible throughout the afternoon and evening. Anticipating low-end chances (10-20%) through midnight.

Wind: Winds will remain out of the ESE throughout the remainder of the day. N Morgan's Point: Winds will be 7 – 12 kts throughout the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 17 - 22 kts for the remainder of the day. Winds near the Boarding Station can remain slightly higher at 22-27 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of up to 30 - 35 kts can be possible south of Morgan's Point after 8PM.






Precip: Scattered rain chances to continue through 5 AM MON before widespread moderate to heavy rain showers enter the area for the majority of the day on Monday beginning at 9AM. Favoring this precip to start working out at 6PM.

Wind: Winds out of the SE through the AM MON before being out of the SSW during the after 9PM. N Morgan's Point: 11-16 kts through 12 PM before a slight decrease to 7-12 kts. S of Morgan's Point: 17-23 kts through 12 PM before a slight decrease to 11-17 kts. Wind gusts of up to 25-28 kts will be possible at all stations through ~6 PM MON.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F.


Visibility: Reduced visibilities will be possible under heavier downpours, with periods of fog able to mix in after 5 PM when rain becomes more scattered. Gusty winds however may limit widespread nature of PM fog


Precip: Scattered rain showers to continue through ~1 PM TUE. After 1 PM, isolated pockets of rain will be possible, however better coverage will remain to the N/W.

Wind: Winds out of the SE the entire day TUE. N of Morgan's Point: 4-9 kts through 12 PM before an increase to 9-14 Kts. S of Morgan's Point: 8-13 kts through 4 PM before a slight increase to 11-16 kts


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near 70 F S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F


Visibility: Fog will continue to be a threat for TUE, with greatest risk in the PM hours.

Wind Speed: 10 PM CT
























- Downpours through Thursday can yield rainfall amounts of 3 5" + rain. Below normal temperatures favored for the week ahead.
