## **Weather Headlines**

- Favoring scattered showers to gradually expand in coverage this AM. Multiple shots of moisture will be present to begin the week.
- Winds expected to remain elevated through the early PM today.
- A Zulu port condition has been issued due to anticipated wave heights to be capable of exceeding 6 ft through 3 PM CT today. Check the wave/text slide for more details
- Sea fog threats look possible starting TUE/WED with numerous shots of showers/thunderstorms. Low confidence exists if sea fog can be observed due to heavy rain and gusty winds helping to mix the atmosphere. Nonetheless, the "ingredients" are still present for sea fog risks



## **Houston Pilots Wave Height Update**






#### **Significant Wave Height Image**

Wave heights will continue to increase into the early morning today, with peak waves reaching from 9 AM – 6 PM CT MON. Wave heights during this time can peak at 6 - 8 feet, with a few swells to 9 ft. Waves then begin a weakening process this evening and are expected to fall below 6 ft after 12 AM CT TUE.




## **Houston Pilots Wind Chart**

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Scattered rain chances to continue through 5 AM before widespread moderate to heavy rain showers enter the area for the majority of the day beginning at 9AM. Favoring this precip to start working out at 6PM.

Wind: Winds out of the SE through the AM MON before being out of the SSW during the after 9PM. N Morgan's Point: 11-16 kts through 12 PM before a slight decrease to 7-12 kts. S of Morgan's Point: 17-23 kts through 12 PM before a slight decrease to 11-17 kts. Wind gusts of up to 25-28 kts will be possible at all stations through ~6 PM MON.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F.


Visibility: Reduced visibilities will be possible under heavier downpours, with periods of fog able to mix in after 5 PM when rain becomes more scattered. Gusty winds however may limit widespread nature of PM fog

### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Scattered rain showers to continue through ~1 PM TUE. After 1 PM, isolated pockets of rain will be possible, however better coverage will remain to the N/W.

Wind: Winds out of the SE the entire day TUE. N of Morgan's Point: 4-9 kts through 12 PM before an increase to 9-14 Kts. S of Morgan's Point: 8-13 kts through 4 PM before a slight increase to 11-16 kts


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near 70 F S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F


Visibility: Fog will continue to be a threat for TUE, with greatest risk in the PM hours.

### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Scattered showers (60-70%) enter the area shortly after 12 AM and impact all Stations through 5 PM. After 5 PM, hit/miss showers (30-40%) remain for Stations S of 51/52 through the remainder of the evening.

Wind: Winds will variable in direction throughout the day. N Morgan's Point: Winds will be 3-8 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 7-12 kts in the early AM will decrease to 4-9 kts by 12 PM. Winds at the Boarding Station will remain slightly higher at 5-10 kts.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.


Visibility: Monitoring potential for patchy fog to occur in gaps between showers Wednesday AM, however showers and winds will aid in mixing the atmosphere.

Wind Speed: 9 AM CT













#### **Next 7 Day Temperature Departure**




**Next 7 Day Total Precipitation** 




**8-14** Day Temperature Departure

- Downpours through Thursday can yield rainfall amounts of 3 5" + rain. Below normal temperatures favored for the week ahead.
- > Slight below rain chances are expected for the week 2 timeframe. Temps expected to warm up becoming above normal for the week 2 timeframe after a very cold stretch the week prior.
- > Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks 3/4 timeframe.
