



Houston Pilots Wind Chart





Forecast Discussion


Precip: While rain showers have exited for today, skies will remain mostly cloudy for the remainder of the afternoon.

Wind: Sustained from the NNW to NW at times this afternoon. N Morgan's Point: 8 - 13 kts prior to 6 PM. After 6 PM winds calm to 5 - 10 kts. S of Morgan's Point: 11 - 16 kts sustained, with the Boarding Station remaining more elevated at 17 - 22 kts. A few wind gusts to 24 - 26 kts cannot be ruled out mainly from 2 PM - 9 PM at the Boarding Station as well.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 40s F S of Morgan's Point: Upper 40s F.


Visibility: Fog threats have ceased over the next few days thanks to this AM's cold front passage.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Strong High pressure will sit across S TX keeping conditions dry Sunday.


Wind: Winds will continue from the NNW. N Morgan's Point: 5 - 10 kts will increase slightly to 6 - 11 kts after 10 AM. After 5 PM winds calm to 3 - 7 kts. S of Morgan's Point: 13 - 18 kts prior to 10 AM. Winds then begin a slow calming trend into the afternoon, at 9 - 14 kts by 2 PM then 6 - 11 kts by 10 PM. Boarding Station winds will start at 14 - 19 kts and calm to 11 - 16 kts by 4 PM.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Monday.

Wind: Winds out of the NNW will become variable after 11 AM, settling out of the S/SSW by 3 PM. N of Morgan's Point: 3-7 kts favored for the entire day. During the wind shift from about 11 AM - 3 PM, winds can be less than 3 kts. S of Morgan's Point: 4-9 kts sustained for the entire day outside of 6 - 11 kts from 12 - 7 AM.


High Temps: Slightly warmer. N of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 50s F.











Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation




8-14 Day Temperature Departure

- ➤ Drier "intermission" will be ongoing through roughly Thursday AM before drizzle can press into the area during the afternoon. Another wave looks to enter on Saturday. Slightly below normal temperatures favored for the week ahead.
- > Slightly above normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps expected to be above normal.
- ➤ Below normal temperatures and much above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ¾ timeframe.
