



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Dry Conditions are favored for most of THU. 10% chances for sprinkles after 10PM-CT will be possible if moisture can move in earlier.

Wind: Winds will remain out of the E for much of the day, becoming out of the ESE by 10PM for all stations. N Morgan's Point: 3 - 7 kits prior to 11 AM, increasing to 7 - 13 kts thereafter. S of Morgan's Point: 8 - 14 knot winds continue through about 9 - 10 AM where they being to pick up, especially towards the boarding station. By 11AM, winds are expected to be sustained around 14 - 18 kts, increasing 16 - 21 knots by 6 PM. Winds at the Boarding Station a touch higher at 18 - 22 kts by 6 PM. Gusts of 23 - 26 knots cannot be ruled out after 6 PM near the Boarding Station.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 50s F. S of Morgan's Point: Lower 60s F.


Visibility: All fog continues to remain to the northwest of stations for this AM and is not anticipated to be a concern for the remainder of the day.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring light drizzle to be possible between 12AM and 3AM for all stations. Rain showers/ storms will be possible from 4 AM – 10 AM. Favoring majority of rain / storm to exit no later than 12 – 1PM. Similar to the event from WED AM, strong gusts will be a possibility.

Wind: E/SE winds are expected through roughly 10 AM before winds being to shift out of the NW (lower confidence on wind shift timing). N of Morgan's Point: 8 -13 kts for most of the day with the exception of 5AM – 10AM when winds increase to 14 – 18 kts. Winds should calm to to 3 – 7 knots after 3 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds of 18 – 23 kts will be possible before winds calm down after 4 – 6 pm to 8 – 13 knots. Sustained winds a touch higher towards the boarding station of 21 – 25 kts. Strong storm gusts of 40 – 50 kts can't be ruled out between ~6AM to ~10AM.






Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Saturday.

Wind: Winds remain out of the north / northwest for Saturday. N Morgan's Point: Winds calm to 3 – 6 knots for most of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds of 8 -12 kts through 2PM, before slightly weakening to 5 – 9 kts.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Lower to mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Lower 60s F


Visibility: Lower confidence in timing and coverage, but **1AM** – **5AM** patchy fog for all stations can't be ruled out.














- Best opportunities for rain will be FRI AM and another on Monday. Some up and down temperatures will be possible this week.
