

Current Weather Alerts:

All Clear

Temperatures:

✓ High temperatures today expected to reach the low-to-mid 50's F.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Partly Cloudy Skies Today.
- ✓ SW winds can bring some gusts near 25 30 in the 9 AM 3 PM window.
- ✓ Winds will gradually begin to shift out of the NW after in 4 PM to 10 PM window.

FORECAST NOTES

Today's Precipitation Chances:

Most of today should be dry. There is a very low-end risk for a passing shower from 6 – 12 AM tonight. Amounts would only be trace.

Rainfall Totals / Icing concerns?

No icing concerns. Current thinking is more likely than not that Chicago is just dry.

Dew/Frost:

Some frost will be possible on grass tomorrow AM – roughly a 30% chance of this occurring. Winds/ low level moisture are borderline into SAT AM.



NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES:

Precipitation:

- ✓ FRI: Only a low-end risk of very light moisture later this evening.
- ✓ <u>SAT-MON:</u> Increased confidence that a system on Monday will be south of the Chicago area leading to a dry stretch. Trends will continue to be monitored.
- ▼ TUE THU: Watching this period closely for some clipper-like systems that can swing through that can provide for rain/ snow opportunities. Confidence in specifics remains very low at this distance. Accumulating snow is not out of the question. It is also worth noting the data varies greatly with the timing of individual system, so there can certainly be plenty of dry stretches. Also note the low percentages as well.

Temperatures:

- ✓ Cold air air filters in behind a front on Cooler air will be in store after today. However, temperatures remain rather mild.
- ✓ Low temperatures once again look to get back to near/ below 32 F into the following weekend.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Sunnier conditions are expected FRI/ SAT and MON with more clouds on Sunday.
- As potential clipper system move into the area next week, an uptick in cloud cover is expected.
- Wind gusts near 30 MPH cannot be ruled out this afternoon. Outside of that, we currently do not see a strong wind signal.
