Current Weather Alerts:

No Active Alerts (All Clear)

Temperatures:

 Potential record high temperatures today.
Application looks underdone on temperatures, and PM highs near 3 PM can reach near 73 F.

Wind/Clouds:

- Mostly Sunny skies in the AM will see increasing cloudiness into the afternoon as rain chances enter
- ✓ Winds can be a touch overdone in the app today by a few mph. Calmest of winds happen ahead of storms from 1 -6 PM today. After 6 PM gusts of 30 -40 mph possible with gusts locally up to 55 mph under a strong T-storm.
- ✓ Winds overnight remain elevated at 30 -40 mph behind the cold front

Today's Precipitation Chances:

With later trends in precipitation, the earliest to watch for an isolated T-storm will be near 6 PM, with the best timing from 8 PM - 1 AM for a locally strong to severe storm. Precipitation chances with T-storms will be hit/miss and hourly forecast handling chances well

Rain + Snow Totals:

A hit/miss fashion will be the theme with storms. If a hit is seen, totals of around 0.25 - 0.5" are possible. Key timeframe for some backside snow showers WED AM will be from 2 -7 AM for a light coating. Potential for a quarter to half inch of snow is possible from the sky, but gusty winds will make snow sticking to surfaces difficult <u>Dew/Frost:</u>

Dew/frost is not favored tomorrow. There is, however, a low end (20-30% chance) for a refreeze with how sharp temperatures drop by sunrise WED AM (mid to upper 20s F near 6 - 8 AM)

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

NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES:

Precipitation:

- ✓ <u>WED</u>: Favoring rain/storms in the early AM to transition to a brief period of snow showers near 2 - 7 AM. Potential for ~0.25 to locally 0.5" from the sky cannot be ruled out. After precip exits, the PM will be dry. At the latest, a flurry can linger until 9 AM.
- ✓ <u>THU</u>: Favoring dry conditions; abundant high pressure follows behind the storm system
- ✓ <u>FRI:</u> A dry, sunny day favored. Data has an idea of a very isolated shower in the PM, but not favored at this time.
- ✓ <u>SAT</u>: Dry conditions continue with high pressure
- ✓ <u>SUN</u>: An isolated shower would be possible in the PM, but it would be dependent on the progression of the storm system in the Northern Plains. Better opportunities for rain will be in store on Monday.

Temperatures:

- Very large temp swing into WED AM as values drop from low 70s to mid 20s F
- ✓ WED/THUR will see seasonable to slightly below temps for a short period before mild air returns into the weekend

Wind/Clouds:

- Skies will be clearing into the early PM WED leaving WED PM through Sunday generally more sunny than cloudy
- ✓ Wednesday PM will remain blustery with gusts of 30 -40 mph. Winds subside after sunset.
- Thursday AM contains calm winds, with an increase to 20 -30 mph with daytime heating from 10 AM 5 PM.
- ✓ Friday again looks on the breezier side, with winds gusting 20 -30 mph
- ✓ SAT/SUN: 15 25 mph mainly during the daytime hours
