

FORECAST NOTES

Current Weather Alerts:

All Clear

Temperatures:

✓ High temperatures today expected to reach the low-to-mid 50's F.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Partly sunny conditions are expected for today.
- ✓ Southerly/ SW winds are expected today generally sustained around 14 18 MPH this afternoon. Wind gust near 35 MPH will be possible this afternoon with wind gusts near 30 MPH possible through midnight.

Today's Precipitation Chances:

Early afternoon light showers will be possible with the main window being in the \sim 6 – 8 PM window for storms. A few of these storms today can be strong to severe in nature with wind gusts of 50+ MPH, large hail, and an isolated tornado being at play. Overall risk is low for severe weather, however. Exact timing is slightly lower confidence and have left rain chances after 8 PM for now to account for some slower solutions. With that in mind, I would lean drier after 8 PM.

Rainfall Totals / Icing concerns?

No loing concerns. Rainfall totals to near 0.5" can't be ruled out if caught directly by a storm. Rainfall amounts will not be uniform across NE IL. Dew/Frost:

Dew is unlikely due to winds. However, grass may remain wet if well sheltered from SW winds.

NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES:

Precipitation:

- ✓ THU: A few storms later this afternoon/ evening will be possible.
- ✓ <u>FRI-SAT:</u> Light rain/ even a flake of snow, will be possible overnight FRI night into early SAT AM. SAT PM is expected to be dry.
- ✓ <u>SUN-MON:</u> Confidence continues to remain low with a lowpressure system SUN night into MON AM. Current thinking is it slides far enough south where Chicago avoids precipitation. Will keep low chances in for now to account for any potential shifts.
- ▼ TUE THU: Watching this period closely for some clipper-like systems that can swing through that can provide for rain/ snow opportunities. Confidence in specifics remains very low at this distance. Accumulating snow is not out of the question.

Temperatures:

- ✓ Cold air air filters in behind a front on FRI. With that being said temperatures still remain mild for this time of year.
- ✓ Overnight lows SUN into the following weekend can reach back to closer to 32 F.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Sunshine will be possible THU, FRI, and especially the back half of SAT. Will need to watch how the system SUN/ MON evolves. However, clouds will be more likely SUN with a better shot for the return of some sun into MON.
- ✓ Wind gusts near 30 MPH cannot be ruled out FRI afternoon. Outside of that, we currently do not see a strong wind signal.
